

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

1. **Data controller**

The Controller, together with its partners, ensures the preparation, organization, and execution of the social and educational event **EUROPEAN GEOMATICS DAYS 2026** (*EVROPSKÉ DNY GEOMATIKY 2026*).

2. **Purposes of Processing Personal Data / Identification of Processed Personal Data**

The Controller processes personal data for the following purposes:

- identifying the event participant as part of their registration and ensuring their access to the event,
- maintaining a registry of event participants for the duration of the event.

Personal data is secured in accordance with technical standards that ensure standard protection of data against unauthorized access or transfer, misuse, loss, or destruction.

The Controller processes the following personal data of the participants: first name, last name, e-mail address, phone number.

3. **Legal Basis for the Processing of Personal Data (Lawfulness of Processing Personal Data)**

Personal data is processed lawfully, as it is processed on the legal ground of necessity for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller (which consists of the proper execution of the event in question), except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject which require protection of personal data.

If the processing of personal data is not necessary for the aforementioned purposes, the Controller carries out the processing based on the consent granted by the participant. The processing of initial personal data provided in the contact form for registration and participation in the event is carried out on the basis of the consent of the participant or the applicant for participation, which is granted within the registration form.

4. **Recipients of Personal Data**

The recipients of the participants' personal data may exclusively be employees of the Controller or the event partner. We obtain personal data solely from the participant as the data subject and not from other sources. The personal data of the participant as the data subject is not transferred abroad, i.e., to a third country or an international organization.

5. **Period of Processing Personal Data**

Unless otherwise provided by law or by a decision of a competent authority, the personal data will be processed only for the duration of the event and will subsequently be handled in accordance with Act No. 110/2019 Coll., on the Processing of Personal Data.

6. **Rights of the Participant in Connection with the Processing of Personal Data**

6.1. **Right of Access to Personal Data**

The participant has the right to obtain confirmation from the Controller as to whether or not personal data concerning them is being processed, and if it is being processed, the right to be informed of which specific data is processed and to be provided with a copy thereof.

6.2. Right to Rectification, Erasure, or Restriction of Processing

The participant has the right to obtain from the Controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning them upon the participant's request. They have the right to have incomplete personal data completed at any time.

The participant has the right to restrict processing if (i) the data subject contests the accuracy of the personal data, in which case processing will be restricted for the time necessary to verify the accuracy of the personal data; (ii) the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests, instead, that its use be restricted; (iii) the controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of processing, but the data subject requires it for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims; (iv) the data subject has objected to the processing as described in Section 6.3 below, in which case processing will be restricted until it is determined whether the legitimate grounds for processing override the data subject's interests or rights and freedoms.

Data for which processing has been restricted must be marked as such by the Controller and, for the duration of the restriction, the Controller must not process them further, except for storing them.

The right to erasure of personal data represents the obligation of the Controller to destroy the personal data processed about the participant, provided that certain conditions arising from the Act on the Processing of Personal Data are met, and if the participant requests it, where such request is required by these regulations.

6.3. Right to Object

The participant has the right to object, on grounds relating to their particular situation, at any time to the processing of personal data concerning them which is based on the legitimate interests of the Controller or a third party, or which is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority.

6.4. Right to Data Portability

The participant has the right to request that their personal data be provided for the purpose of transmitting them to another data controller, or that they be transmitted to another data controller in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format. However, the participant only has this right with respect to data that is processed by automated means on the basis of consent or a contract with the data subject. The Controller does not carry out automated processing of personal data.

6.5. Right to Withdraw Consent to the Processing of Personal Data at Any Time

In the event that the Controller processes personal data based on the participant's consent, the participant has the right to withdraw their consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

The right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data at any time does not apply, and the data will continue to be processed, in cases where the data is processed on a legal basis other than consent.

6.6. Right to Lodge a Complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection

In the event that the participant believes the Controller is processing personal data unlawfully, they may lodge a complaint, request, or objection directly with the Controller, in writing using the contact details provided above, or contact the Office for Personal Data Protection (Úřad pro ochranu osobních údajů), with its registered office at Pplk. 7. Cookies

The website of the Controller / event uses or may use cookies. Cookies are files that are stored by the browser on the participant's device, whereby the participant can affect the scope or duration of their acceptance through their device settings or by performing the relevant actions, provided that if the necessary cookies ensuring the technical functionality of the website in the legitimate interest of the Controller are not accepted by the participant, access to the Controller's website may not be enabled for the participant. The participant may withdraw their granted consent at any time.

In addition to the Controller's own files, their website may potentially use external services that also store their own cookies – so-called third-party cookies. The acceptance or rejection of these cookies on the participant's device is managed in the same manner as in the case of the Controller's cookies.

In addition to the technical functionality of the website, cookies may enable the recognition of the browser, or allow the website to retain (remember) the participant's preferences for a certain period of time, thereby optimizing the participant's interaction with the website and allowing the Controller to optimize its messages to meet the participant's needs. Furthermore, cookies may collect analytical data.

Cookies do not cause any damage to computers or similar devices and do not contain any viruses.
