CRRA Greenspace Committee

The Cougar Ridge Residents Association (CRRA) Greenspace Committee is pleased to share an update on several community enhancement initiatives currently underway in the CRRA community.

Seasonal Planting Program

We are excited to announce that Pixie Gardens has started the 2026 seasonal planting program throughout the community. New flowers and plantings have been installed in entrance features, medians, pathway locations, and decorative pots to help keep Cougar Ridge vibrant and welcoming throughout the summer season. Maintenance will continue throughout the season.

During June, Pixie Gardens will begin maintenance of greenspace shrub gardens in the five smaller park & playground areas and select pathways.

Over the years, the partnership between CRRA and Pixie Gardens has contributed to many of the community's signature landscape features and seasonal enhancements. Their expertise and ongoing support have helped maintain the attractive streetscapes and public spaces that residents enjoy year after year.

Looking ahead, the Greenspace Committee is exploring additional opportunities with Pixie Gardens to further enhance community amenities and beautification projects. We look forward to sharing more information as these initiatives develop.

Community Entrance Features

The committee continues to address the theft and vandalism of several community entrance features.

Over the past two years, all four of the original cougar entrance features were stolen. CRRA has replaced two of these features, and approved quotations have been secured for the remaining two. Fabrication and installation will proceed following final release by CRRA.

In addition, several Cougar Ridge logo features were stolen this spring. The committee is currently evaluating options for replacement, including both similar designs and potential new feature concepts that will complement the community's identity.

Paskapoo Sign Restoration

CRRA is also planning repairs to the Paskapoo entrance sign located at the corner of 85th Street SW and Paskapoo Drive SW. The committee is assessing restoration requirements and will provide further updates as the project advances.

Working with the City of Calgary

The Greenspace Committee has recently established contacts and met with representatives from several City of Calgary departments. These discussions have created new opportunities for collaboration and future community improvements.

As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance the CRRA community, the committee will continue exploring partnerships and initiatives with the City that may support beautification, infrastructure improvements, and other enhancements that benefit residents.
