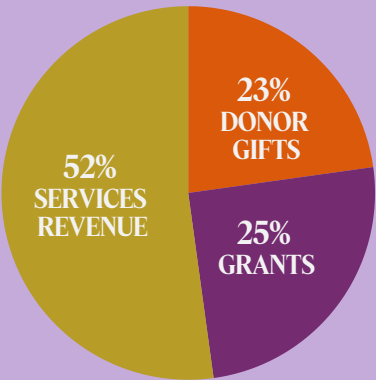

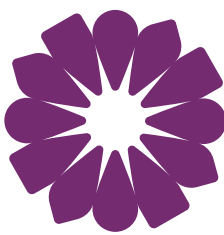
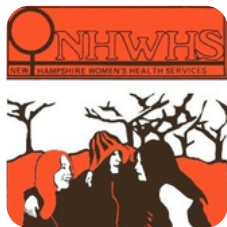

2025 In Review



BROADER ACCESS TO CARE

Our telehealth Medication Abortion program launched in Q1, making at-home pill abortion accessible for patients in all corners of the state without needing to travel in to us. We were awarded an Opportunity Grant from Endowment for Health which enabled a comprehensive clinical document translation project: all patient forms are now available in 6 languages to supplement real-time translating services available on-site. We continue to train next generation values-aligned providers, ensuring queer care and abortion care remain accessible tomorrow.

FRESH LOOK, SAME CARE SINCE 1974

It was time. We intentionally returned to retro-inspired colors, including the foundational orange from the original 1974 poster. The design update, led by Onlychild Design, informed a full-scale digital refresh & updated outreach and education materials.

BRINGING ART BACK IN

Art as a tool for community outreach harkens back to our clinic's earliest days: *WomenWise* was full of original art alongside health information and consciousness raising content. Our new artist-in-residence program is bringing art back to the conversation.

CANCER SCREENINGS FOR ALL

Proud to serve as a screening site for the NH Breast & Cervical Cancer Program, we hosted all day screening clinics to boost awareness of early detection. Three of our patients are now in cancer treatment as a result of screenings by our providers.

HERE FOR THE LONG RUN

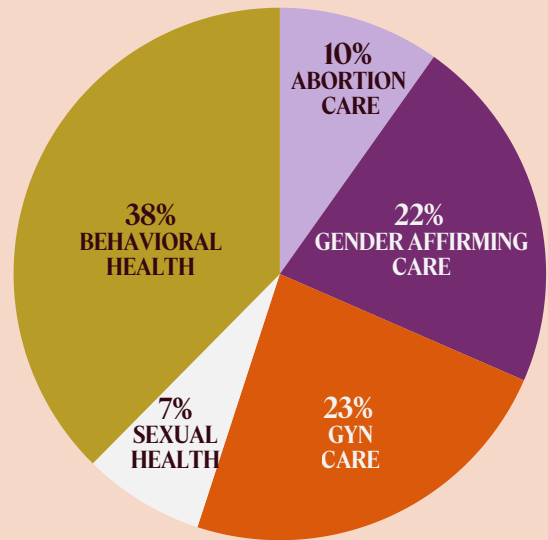
We stood proud with our repro and LGBTQ+ coalition allies to advocate for laws that are inclusive and just. We had some big losses: HB 377 banned gender-affirming care for minors; and wins: HB 476, a 15-week abortion ban withdrew due to broad lack of legislative support.

Committed to joy as resistance, we celebrated with our LGBTQ+ community at 7 different Pride festivals around the state. Our organization hosted the 2nd annual Pride 5K Race in June, welcoming 432 participants to Concord.
