Services

Located in Concord, NH, the Equality Health Center is a free-standing 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization. For over 50 years, the Health Center has provided care to people of all genders and sexual orientations, regardless of their ability to pay. The Health Center services include gynecological care, wellness visits, family planning services, HIV and STI testing, counseling, treatments, transgender care, medication & surgical abortions.

The role

Equality Health Center is seeking a compassionate and experienced clinician to join our team in a part-time, temporary capacity. This position is expected to provide approximately **16–24 hours per week** to support patient care during a planned staffing transition. The anticipated assignment is approximately **6–9 months**, with the potential for extension based on organizational needs.

This is an excellent opportunity for an experienced clinician who enjoys practicing with a high level of autonomy in a supportive, mission-driven environment. The successful candidate will independently manage patient care within their scope of practice while collaborating closely with the Medical Director and the clinical team.

The clinician will provide comprehensive reproductive and sexual healthcare, including gynecological services, contraceptive care, family planning, abortion care, STI care including HIV prophylaxis, and gender-affirming hormone therapy, consistent with licensure, training, and the Health Center's clinical protocols.

- Current New Hampshire licensure as a PA, APRN
- DEA registration

- Experience providing reproductive and gynecological healthcare
- Experience with abortion care, point-of-care ultrasound, and/or gender-affirming hormone therapy is preferred
