Dress Code Policy Debate

Current policy deemed non-compliant with DOE guidelines

Contentious discussion on appropriate language and enforcement

Parents expressed concerns about sexism and targeting of female students

Agreement to revise survey for parent input, including option for no changes

Specific changes discussed:

Replace "no do-rags" with "no headgear"

Change "no exposed shoulders or midriff" to apply to all students

Address open-heel shoes as safety concern

Next Steps

Revise dress code survey to include specific proposed changes and option for no changes

Administer revised dress code survey to parents

Research Junior National Honor Society implementation requirements

Review SLT membership composition for compliance with DOE regulations
