Our Neonatal Resource Services (NRS) is a program that is designed to bring hope and comfort to families. During the program, neonatal nurses (registered nurses) can help answer your questions and give you one-on-one compassionate care after your delivery. NRS is completely voluntary and provided at no additional cost, as part of your benefits plan. To sign up, call **1-866-534-7209**, TTY **771**, 8 a.m.-5 p.m. CT, Monday-Friday.

During the program, your neonatal nurse can help you:

- Work with NICU hospitals to make sure your baby gets the right care.
- Get you ready for life at home with baby and offer support with breastfeeding and postpartum emotions.
- · Arrange for home care services and equipment.
- Answer questions about health benefits and help coordinate preauthorization.

To take part in the NRS program, call a neonatal nurse toll-free at 1-866-534-7209, TTY 711, from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. CT, Monday-Friday, excluding holidays.
