



OSHA Forklift Operator Qualification Training
(1 day)

This course is designed for persons who want to obtain a Forklift Operator Certification. The primary emphasis of this course is to provide the student with the required information and training to enable him/her to successfully pass written and practical examinations that meet the requirements set forth in the ANSI B-56.5, B56.6 and CFR 1926/1910 standards. Candidates who successfully pass the exams will receive a 3-year Certification of Qualification.

This Course is designed for participants that have (50 Hours of Seat Time) experience in forklift operations. The course exposes participants to a variety of equipment and applications which include multiple equipment lifts, securing loads, lift attachments, personnel platforms, incline planes and managing the center-of-gravity.
