

OSHA Aerial Lift/MEWP Qualification Training (1 day)

This Competent Person Training course goes far beyond the basic awareness level that many OSHA courses provide for MEWPs. Since the competent person is required to make critical decisions, they must receive much more in-depth training to create a safe environment for workers, as outlined in the OSHAs standards. This MEWP (Bucket Truck/Aerial Lift Operator program teaches the technical knowledge required to operate safely and the inspection knowledge to recognize concerns.

This program ensures equipment operators are fully aware of the hazards associated with MEWPs and understand their responsibility for continual safety. Course covers boom supported, scissor and articulating MEWP lift types with hands-on training.

This program has a compliance basis of OSHA & New ANSI A-92 regulations and specific state and Government agency requirements where applicable. Learn the technical aspects of MEWPs to keep your operations safe. This course is applicable to US and Canadian standards and regulations.
