

How NYSNA Might Spend **Your Money**

More members = more dues = more money for NYSNA

Last year, NYSNA collected nearly **\$65 million** in dues from its members. But NYSNA spent only about **28%** of that money on the nurses it represents.¹

Instead of spending money on the nurses it represents, NYSNA spent:

\$22 million on union payroll costs

\$2 million on political activities and lobbying

\$1.5 million on food and drinks

\$1.4 million on hotels like The Kartrite Resort & Indoor Waterpark

\$1.2 million paying for multiple office spaces

TOTALLING: \$28.1 million



And these are just the \$1 million+ expenses. The union also spent:

More than half a million on temps — not for hospitals, but for their own administrative purposes

Over \$200,000 on luxury transportation — including charter busses for "lobbying days"

Nearly \$30,000 on entertainment — from live music to event DJs
