# Mammography Papilloma Protocol Post BX

## Refer to Surgeon for any Risk Factor when > 1 cm or

#### Risk Factors:

- Atypia ADH, ALH, FEA or LCIS
- Imaging
  - o > 1 cm pre biopsy
  - Multifocal
  - Calcifications associated
  - Architectural distortion associated on imaging
  - o Discordance Rad-Path
- Symptomatic
  - o Palpable
  - Discharge
- Contralateral known cancer

### F/U Imaging 2-year stability when < 1 cm and

- No other risk factors
- Solitary, < 1 cm pre biopsy

#### Bi-Rads 2

Recommendation: 6 month follow up – mammogram w/RA mags, US (RA, quadrant) @ 6 mo (uni), 12 mo (bilat), 24 mo (bilat) with bx as indicated

(Clinically based discussion / decision, may refer to surgery)
