Papilloma Protocol Post BX

Refer to Surgeon for any Risk Factor when > 1 cm or

Risk Factors:

- Atypia – ADH, ALH, FEA or LCIS
- Imaging –
 - > 1 cm pre biopsy
 - Multifocal
 - Calcifications associated
 - Architectural distortion associated on imaging
 - Discordance Rad-Path
- Symptomatic –
 - Palpable
 - Discharge
- Contralateral known cancer

F/U Imaging 2-year stability when < 1 cm and

- No other risk factors
- Solitary, < 1 cm pre biopsy

*Assumes adequate sample

*Document residual post biopsy

Bi-Rads 2

Recommendation: 6 month follow up – mammogram w/RA mags, US (RA, quadrant)
@ 6 mo (uni), 12 mo (bilat), 24 mo (bilat) with bx as indicated

(Clinically based discussion / decision, may refer to surgery)
