Dear Customer,

We are writing to provide an update on our ongoing efforts in the Quail Pond Court area.

Safety Monitoring:

Washington Gas continues to carry out a comprehensive, multi-phase monitoring and leak detection plan in both the immediate and expanded areas.

- The immediate area has progressed to **Phase 4 monitoring**. During this phase, our teams will conduct leak surveys every other week for at least two months.
 - Phase 3 monitoring concluded on April 3, after two weeks of weekly surveys found no grade 1 or 2 below-ground leaks or hazardous above-ground leaks.

- The expanded area has progressed to **Phase 2 monitoring**. During this phase, our teams will conduct leak surveys once per month for at least two months.
 - Phase 1 monitoring concluded after confirmation that no grade 1 or grade 2 below-ground leaks or hazardous above-ground leaks exist within the area.

If conditions change and data indicates that additional monitoring is needed, we are prepared to increase the frequency or scope of our work.
