Dear Customer,

Washington Gas has **completed** its comprehensive, multi-phase monitoring and leak detection plan in the Quail Pond Court area.

- **Phase 4** monitoring has been completed in the immediate area. During this phase, our crews conducted leak surveys every other week for two months.
- **Phase 2** monitoring has concluded in the expanded area. During this phase, our crews conducted monthly leak surveys for two months.

In total, our teams conducted three months of enhanced monitoring across both areas. Monitoring progressed through each phase and concluded only after confirming that no Grade 1 or Grade 2 below-ground leaks—or hazardous above-ground leaks—were present.
