Partnership with Institute of Reformed Biblical Counseling (IRBC)

In this revamped MABC program, we are becoming more closely integrated with the Institute of Reformed Biblical Counseling (IRBC). They are revamping their certification pathways into two levels, with level 1 being for church members and lay leaders. Level 2 is for pastors and seminary graduates with training. Our new MABC program will integrate more closely with the Level 2 certification, with a large majority of the requirements for certification being included in our MABC curriculum.
