DETOXIFICATION PROGRAM

Our Detoxification Program is designed for people who want to stop using substances, but struggle with the barriers of withdrawal and cravings. Whether a person is struggling with opioids, stimulants, alcohol, kratom, or prescription medications, our Detoxification Program offers a powerful reset – interrupting destructive patterns and returning something many have lost: the ability to choose. Unlike most detox and maintenance models, Ambio’s program is designed to interrupt destructive patterns without chaining you to new ones. While detox from most substances can be long, painful, and unpredictable, ibogaine is the only known medicine with mounting clinical evidence showing it can quickly mitigate most difficult symptoms of withdrawal.

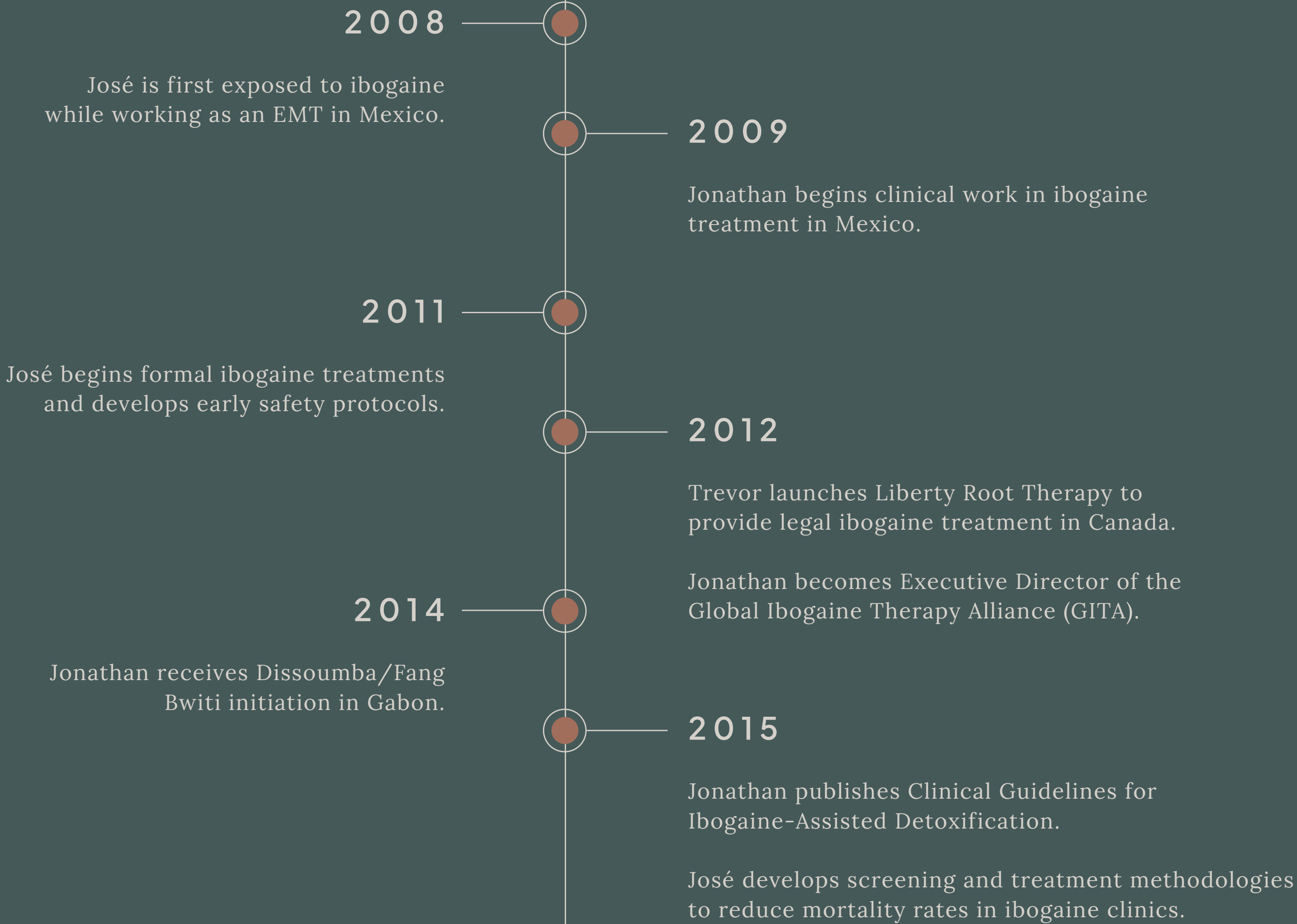


NEUROREGENERATIVE PROGRAM

Our Neuroregenerative Program was designed for people living with conditions like Parkinson’s, multiple sclerosis (MS), essential tremors, and other neurodegenerative conditions who wish to explore the use of ibogaine for these conditions. Using optimized loading doses followed by extended microdosing, **the protocol targets regeneration and an improved quality of life in the long term – backed by emerging data, ongoing research, and human-centric care.** This treatment uses an optimized ‘loading dose’ of ibogaine, ideal for people with physical challenges or age-related concerns, as a precursor to extended microdosing. Treatment occurs in accessible facilities, with continuous medical supervision and supportive physiotherapy designed to honor the complexity of chronic illness.

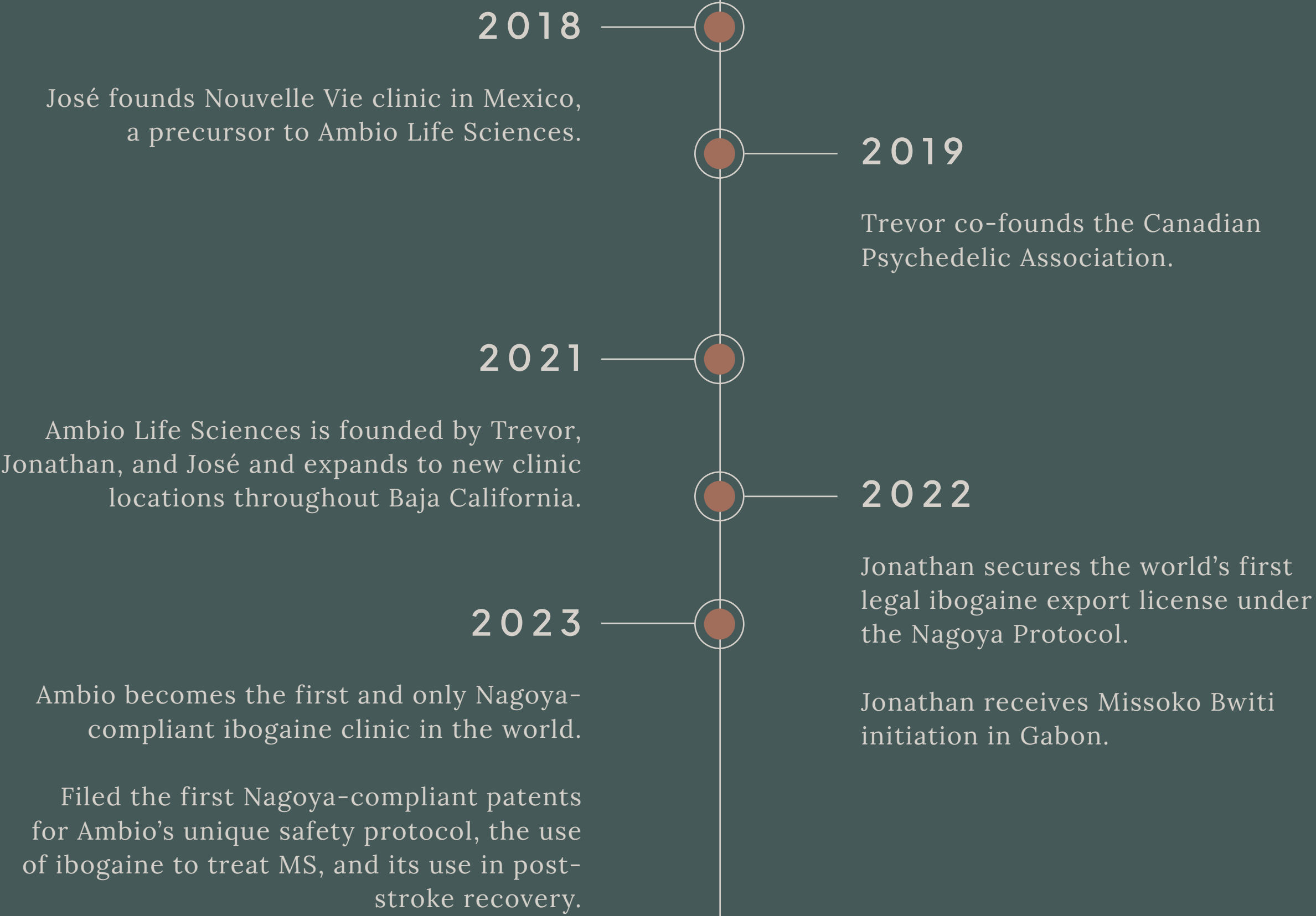

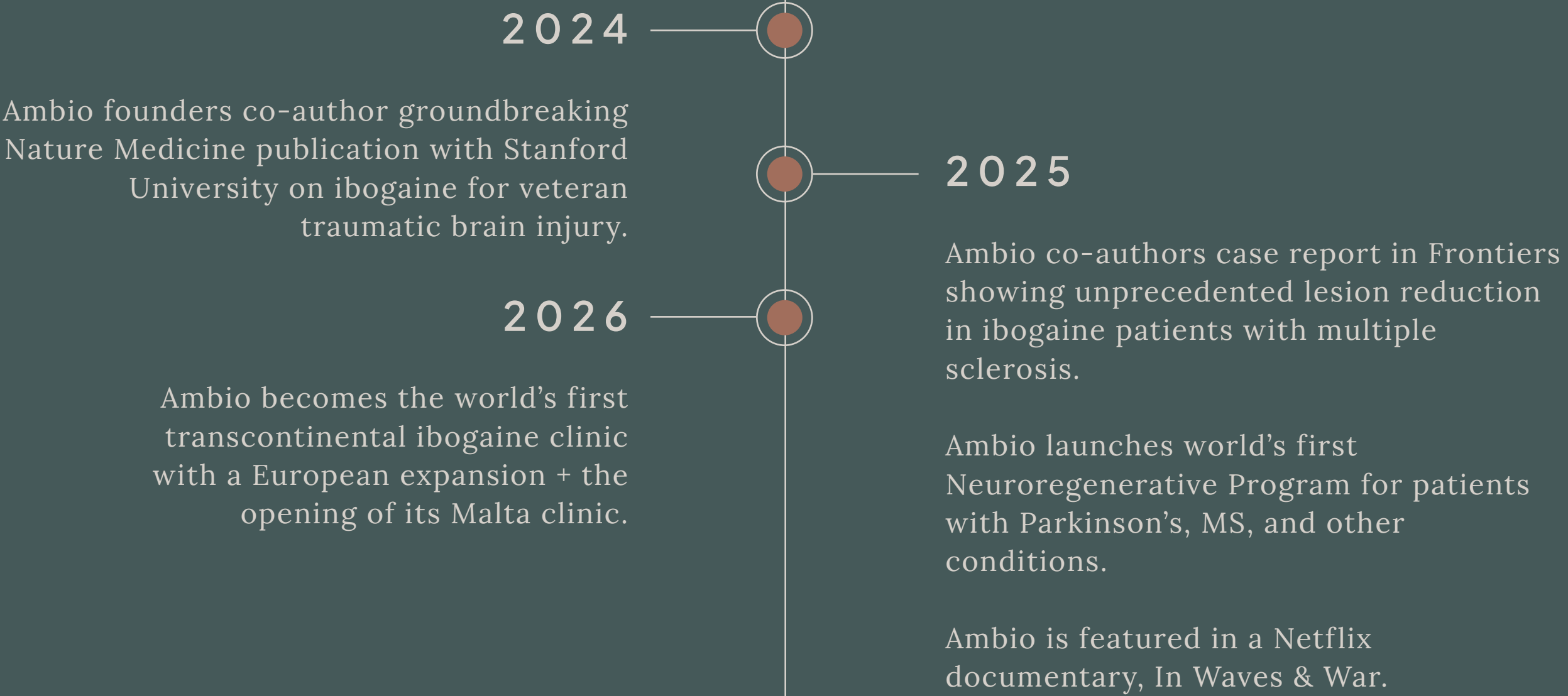

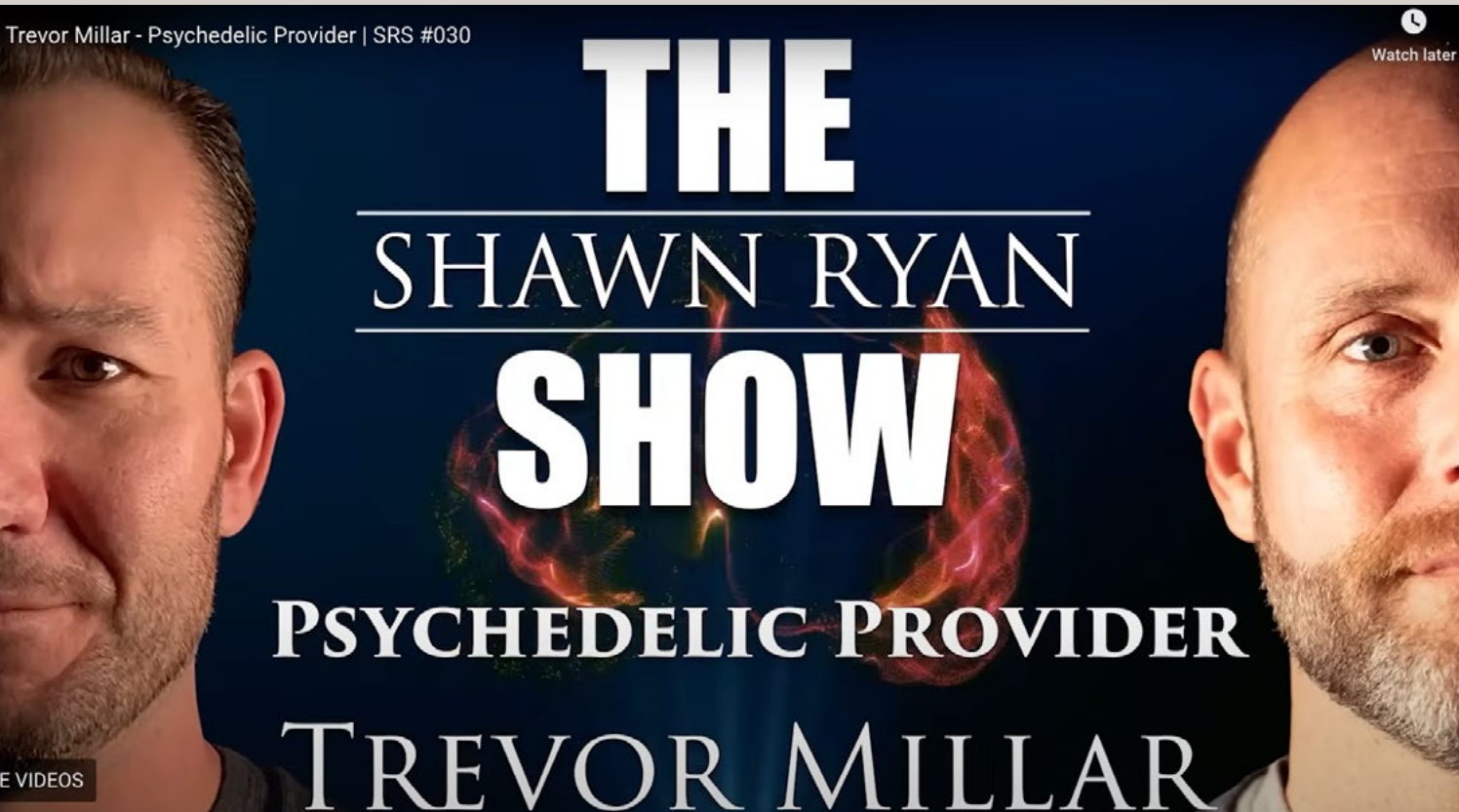

What is ibogaine?

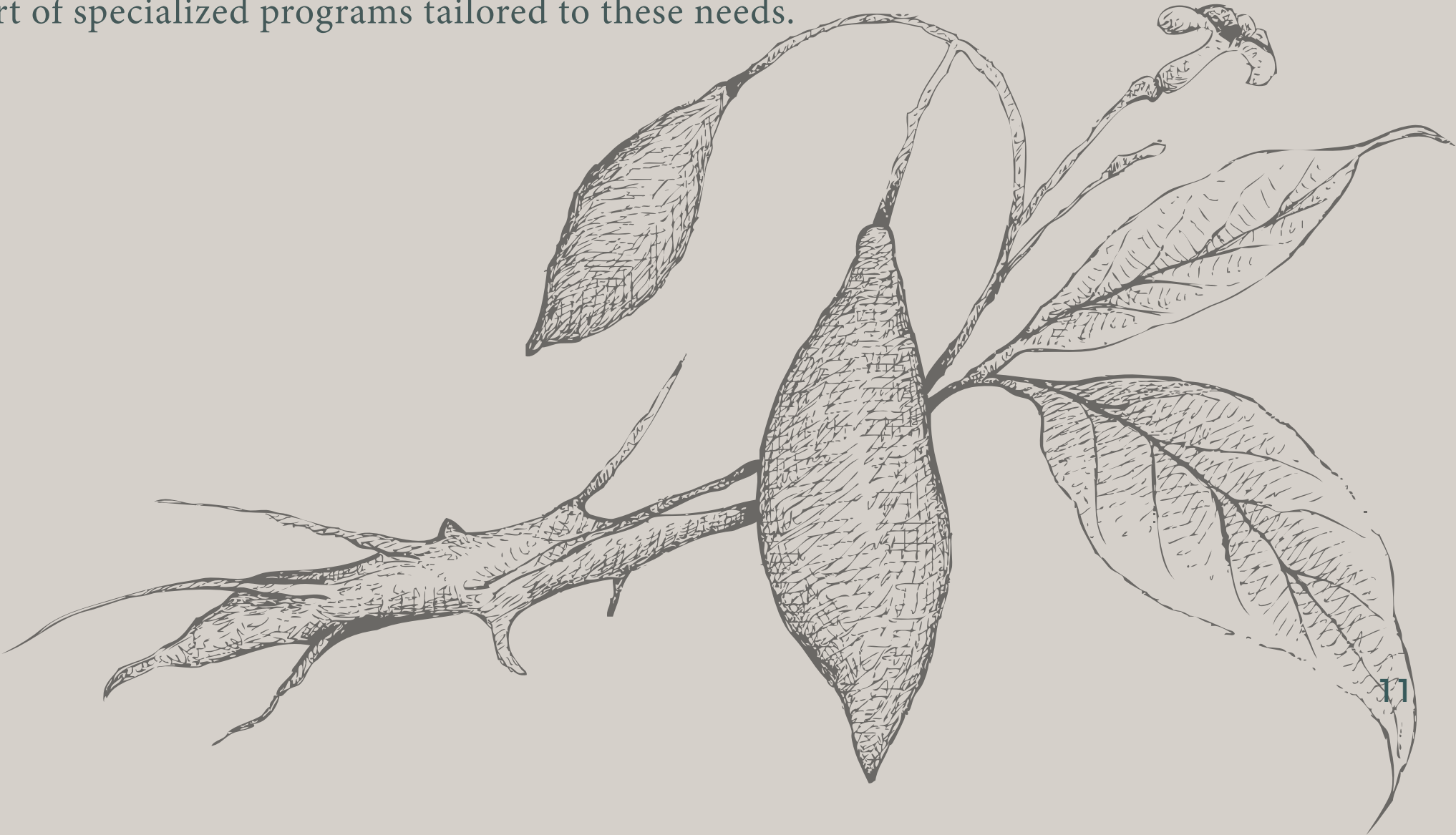
Ibogaine is a plant-derived medicinal alkaloid with powerful psychoactive and neuroregenerative effects. It’s traditionally used in Central Africa for healing and initiation, and today, it’s used clinically to interrupt addiction, improve neurological function, and support deep personal transformation.

How does ibogaine work in the body?

Ibogaine is believed to engage multiple systems at once, including serotonin, dopamine, opioid receptors, NMDA receptors, and more. It also appears to trigger neuroplasticity and increase neurotrophic factors like BDNF and GDNF, which support healing, mood regulation, and functional recovery. It is one of the most pharmacologically complex medicines on earth.

What conditions can ibogaine help treat?

Ibogaine has been most studied for addiction, but shows promising effects in treating mental health issues, neuropathic pain, traumatic brain injury (TBI), Parkinson’s disease, and multiple sclerosis, among others. At Ambio, we deliver ibogaine as part of specialized programs tailored to these needs.

Where does
ibogaine come
from?

Ibogaine is primarily derived from the root bark of Tabernanthe iboga, a rainforest shrub native to Central and West Africa. For clinical use, it’s typically extracted from other ibogaine-rich plants to ensure sustainability. Ambio is committed to ethical sourcing and works in partnership with communities in West-Central Africa.

Is there scientific
research behind
ibogaine?

Yes. While research is still emerging, peer-reviewed studies and case reports show ibogaine’s impact on addiction, neurological function, and mood regulation. Ambio has contributed to research published in Nature Medicine and Frontiers in Immunology, including a seminal 2024 Stanford-collaborated study that showed unprecedented neuroregeneration in 30 Navy SEAL veterans with TBI, following one ibogaine treatment at Ambio Life Sciences.

What is the
ibogaine experience
like at Ambio?

The experience is deeply internal and varies from person to person. Most describe it as a dreamlike, introspective journey where memories, emotions, and insights emerge. Patients are supported by our staff at every moment and monitored for safety in a calming, clinical setting.

How is the treatment process structured?

Treatment begins with comprehensive pre-screening, including medical review, lab work, and an EKG. Once admitted, patients receive their ibogaine flood dose in a medically monitored session lasting 12–24 hours. Each treatment is tailored to the patient’s physiology and history, and supported by an experienced team in a secure, therapeutic environment.

What safety protocols are in place?

Safety is our top priority. Every treatment includes:

- Cardiac and vitals monitoring during ibogaine treatment
- Detailed medical screening for suitability
- On-site medical teams trained in emergency response
- Clinical-grade treatment rooms outfitted like cardiac ICUs
- Individualized dosing and magnesium supplementation
- Full post-treatment observation and recovery

Why do you treat with ibogaine in Mexico and Malta?

Ibogaine is not legal in the United States, where ibogaine remains a Schedule I substance. In Mexico and Malta, ibogaine is unscheduled and can be administered safely and legally under medical supervision.
