How to Contribute

If you would like to share your work with Soul & Law:

1. Prepare your piece in English.
 2. Include a short author note with 2 - 4 sentences about who you are and what inspired your text
 3. Send your submission or idea to our editorial team at **soullaw.org@gmail.com**
 4. You will receive a confirmation within a few days
- If your piece is selected, we may share light feedback or small edits before publication

We also welcome unfinished ideas or outlines if you are unsure write to us anyway.

Submission Guidelines

- Submissions must be original and unpublished elsewhere
- Credit all sources when referencing external materials
- Do not include personal or identifying details without explicit consent
- Submissions may be lightly edited for clarity and ethical sensitivity while preserving the author's voice.

Editorial Process

All submissions are reviewed by our editorial collective. We may suggest small revisions or discuss the best publication format. The main criterion is alignment with the spirit and tone of Soul & Law.
