

Integration Of Midwifery Models Of Care

Oklahoma is steadily advancing toward broader integration of midwifery models within hospital-based maternity care. In recent months, several hospitals across the state have taken meaningful steps by hiring Certified Nurse-Midwives (CNMs) and expanding collaborative care teams.

This symposium marked the first step toward advancing CNM integration in Oklahoma. Leaders explored collaborative care models to expand access, improve outcomes, and strengthen hospital workforce capacity. Planning partners from across the state contributed to this shared vision.

This shift reflects growing recognition of midwifery's role in improving outcomes, enhancing patient satisfaction, and supporting culturally responsive care. While full integration remains a work in progress, the momentum is encouraging—and signals a more inclusive future for maternity care in Oklahoma.
