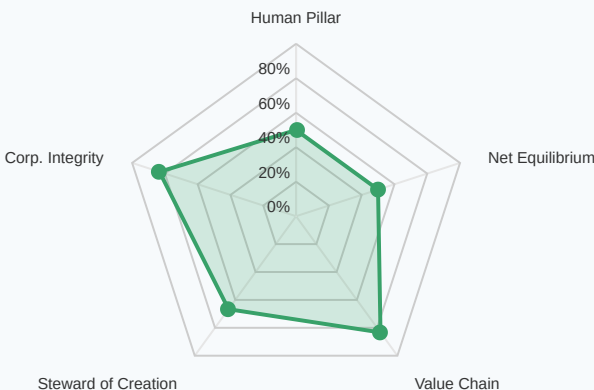

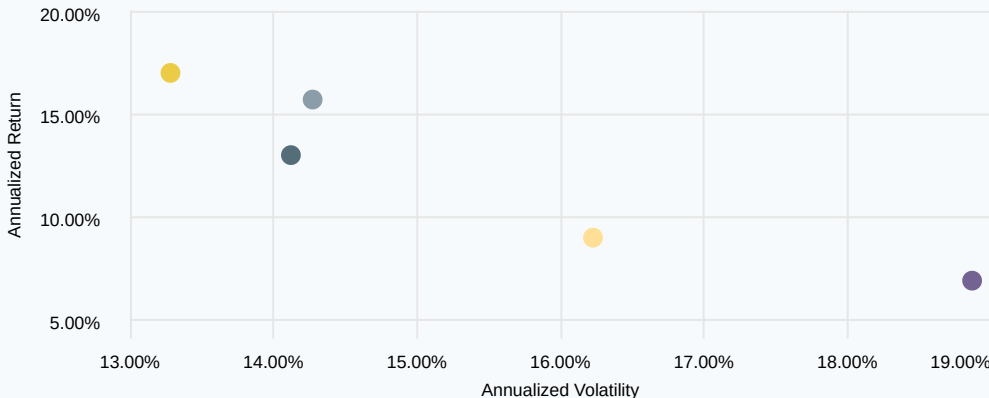

### OCR (Ongoing Charges Ratio)

Indicates the total annual cost of owning and managing an investment fund. It is expressed as a percentage of the fund's total assets.

### MTD (Month to Date)

Return of the financial instrument since the start of the current month.

### YTD (Year to Date)

Return of the financial instrument since the start of the current year.

### 3Y

Return of the financial instrument in the period of the last three years.

### Ann. R. (Annualized Return)

Annualized return in the period of analysis detailed at the beginning of the report.

### Ann. V. (Annualized Volatility)

Annualized volatility in the period of analysis detailed at the beginning of the report.

### SR (Sharpe Ratio)

Annualized Sharpe ratio in the period of analysis detailed at the beginning of the report.

### MDD (Maximum Drawdown)

Maximum fall in the period of analysis detailed at the beginning of the report.

### Violations

The weighting of holdings within a portfolio that are invested in controversial activities (e.g., gambling, adult entertainment, weapons) as defined by fundamental Christian ethics. The table shows the activities that carry the largest weight in the portfolio.

### Excellence

A score reflecting the financial product's alignment with areas considered positive under core Christian ethical principles. This includes, but is not limited to, commitment to Stewardship of Creation and evidence of high corporate integrity.

Upholding honesty and strong Christian standards, preventing bribery, corruption and immorality within a company.

Percentage of the financial instrument's weight for which data is available.

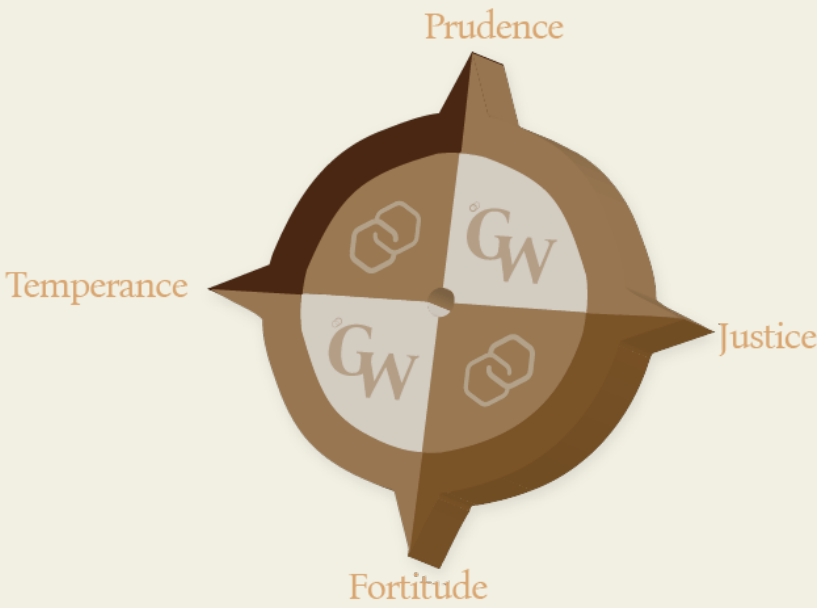
### Level of Transparency
