



1,152 clients visited our Resource Center

Drop-In Support | Showers, lounge, appointments, and referrals to community resources

796 survivors received legal advocacy

Legal Advocacy | Help navigating the court system, seeking restraining orders, and more

553 survivors gained independence

Self-Sufficiency | Resources for employment, educational advancement, and stable housing



All of our **services are free of charge**, no matter what someone's income level is.

We accept all survivors no matter one's race, age, sexual orientation, religion, gender, ability, cultural or socio-economic background.

Upwards of **100 family pets** also find shelter at Safe Haven each year, including dogs, cats, rodents, bunnies, reptiles, and birds.

Accepting beloved pets eliminates a huge barrier for survivors when deciding to leave an abusive situation.

Youth Advocates supported **463 children** by helping strengthen their sense of self, build confidence, and overcome trauma.

Monthly activity bags were home-delivered to **83 kids** to foster connection and trust.

Friday Night Fun for children in shelter includes movies, games, crafts and more.

Youth practice resilience while connecting with peers in a safe environment at **Shine Brite summer camp**, which includes yoga and paddle boarding.

In addition, **weekly support groups** provided space to heal, support, and empower **172 adult survivors** at our Resource Center.
