SAFER SPACES

SAFE SPACE
Reading train station will have a staffed safe space which provides a safe location for anyone who feels they are in immediate danger. Please speak to station staff. There will also be Reading Street Pastors and railway children located at the station during certain times

SAFE STORAGE & LOST PROPERTY
Festivalgoers can leave their bags and valuable items at this facility if they don't want to take it into the arena.

SALVATION ARMY
Providing a listening ear in confidence. Affordable drinks and hot food too.

SAMARITANS
Samaritans will give you the time and space to talk things through, so you can find a way through any problems. You can talk to us any time you like, in your own way, about whatever's getting to you and in complete confidence.

STAMP OUT SPIKING
Providing a tent in Green Fields holding conversations around spiking, raising awareness and stamping out spiking.

STAND UP AGAINST STREET HARRASMENT BY L'OREAL
Campaigning to stand up against street harrasment, pop in to see their activation.

STREET PASTORS
Safe places for people feeling overwhelmed or who just need somewhere to go & sit. Feeling vulnerable or just fed up? Go speak to them. Grab a bite to eat. They also patrol the campsites.
