The Solidarity Fund helps you when you don't have enough money for housing - for example, with rent, the equity deposit*, or in special financial emergencies.

It's a gesture of solidarity from the community. All residents make monthly contributions to this fund.

Financial support is available to residents of Kalkbreite and Zollhaus, as well as to members who apply for an apartment with us but don't have enough money for the equity deposit*.

We can help if...

- you can't pay your rent.
- you don't have enough money for the equity contribution.
- you're facing a special financial emergency, such as a separation, illness, or job loss.

There are no set amounts. We'll determine how much help you need.

How do you go about it?

1. Fill out a form and attach the necessary documents regarding your income and property.
2. Submit it to the office (Geschäftsstelle) or send it to solifonds@kalkbreite.net.
3. The Solidarity Commission will look at your application and then respond to you.

Your information will be treated confidentially and with respect.

Decisions are based on clear, transparent criteria.

Depending on the type of financial support requested, we require different documents.

A

If you are unable to pay the rent or the equity contribution

→ **Completed and signed application**

→ **The following documents:**

- Pay stubs for all individuals living in the same household, showing current hours worked for the past six months;
- Most recent tax return
- Most recent final tax bill
- Proof of financial support (AHV, IV, social assistance, scholarships, etc.)
- Approval or rejection letters from public or private funding sources Pension fund statement

If you need individual help for a financial emergency

→ **Completed and signed application**

→ **The following documents:**

- Invoice, cost estimate, or confirmation
- If available: Approval or rejection letters from other funding sources
