We are delighted to share the remarkable milestones achieved- 35 of these children will be going to our own new school!

### Academic Progress & Student Success

We celebrate significant academic achievements within our sponsored children's programs:

- Over 10 students advanced to candidate classes (Primary 7, Senior 4 and Senior 6), preparing to join secondary schools, vocational institutions, and universities.
- All other students successfully progressed to the next class level, demonstrating resilience and commitment to their education.

### Opening of Nyimusa International School – Nursery Section

Education remains at the core of our mission, and this year we reached a historic milestone: the official opening of Nyimusa International School (Nursery Section).

This marks the beginning of our broader vision to establish:

- A fully equipped primary school
- A modern vocational training institute
- A safe, nurturing, and transformative learning environment for all children in the community

We were honored to welcome the Swedish delegation to the opening, led by Sofia and Bengt, alongside the Swedish Ambassador in Uganda, Maria Håkansson, whose presence reaffirmed our shared commitment to quality education.

**Registration for the Nursery Section is ongoing** ready to start classes in January, and we are still looking for 6 new sponsors for students in the new school - please spread the word on our behalf! 😊

- Tomatoes
- Ginger
- Passion fruits
