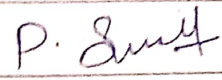
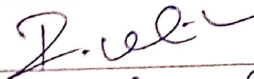
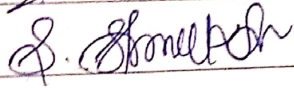
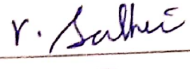
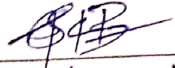
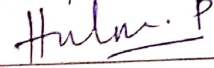
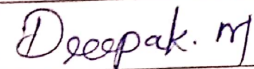
Item 43.3: As there were no other matters to discuss, the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by the Coordinator.

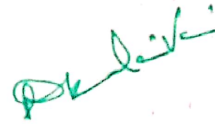
