OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A purchase does not improve your chances of winning. OPEN ONLY TO LEGAL RESIDENTS OF THE 50 UNITED STATES (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF NEW YORK AND FLORIDA), THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, AND CANADA, WHO ARE, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY, AT LEAST EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OLD OR THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THEIR JURISDICTION OF RESIDENCE. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

1. Eligibility

Open to individuals who are (a) legal residents of the fifty United States, the District of Columbia, or Canada, except residents of New York and Florida, (b) the age of majority in their province, state, or territory of residence at the time of entry, and (c) currently enrolled students, faculty, or staff at one of the following participating institutions during the entry period: University of Guelph, Pomona College, University of Victoria, UCLA, Simon Fraser University, UC Riverside, Roosevelt University, Occidental College, Seattle University, Eastern Illinois University, Texas A&M, University of Wisconsin Oshkosh, Delta State University, Trinity College, MacEwan University (“Participating Institutions”). Employees of Circular Solutions Inc. (“Reusables” or “sponsor”), its affiliates, agencies, each Participating Institution’s dining/food-service operations, and their immediate families are not eligible. Void where prohibited. “Immediate family” is defined as parents, siblings, children and spouse.

2. Entry period

The entry period begins August 17, 2026 at 12:00:00 a.m. PT and ends December 1, 2026 at 11:59:59 p.m. PT (“Entry Period”). Reusables’ system clock is the official timekeeper.

3. How to enter

There are two ways to enter. Both offer an equal chance of winning, and each eligible individual may receive a maximum of one (1) entry total for the duration of the promotion, regardless of method or combination of methods used.

Reuse entry: A “qualifying use” is one reusable container borrowed through a Reusables checkout and returned in acceptable condition to a Smart Return Bin™ or Smart Return Station within the standard return window, at a Participating Institution during the Entry Period. Completing two (2) qualifying uses earns one (1) entry, awarded automatically to the individual associated with the account that borrowed the containers. Uses that are not returned, are returned damaged, or are reversed for any reason do not count. Completing more than two qualifying uses does not earn additional entries. In the event of a dispute, all qualifying uses will be deemed to have been made by the owner of the Reusables account through which the containers were borrowed.

Free entry (no reuse required): You do not need to use the Reusables app, hold a Reusables account, or complete any reuse activity to enter. Submit the online entry form at <https://reusables.com/use-twice-entry> with your name, email address, phone number, mailing address, and campus, at any time during the Entry Period, for one (1) entry. Limit one entry per person via this method; duplicate submissions from the same person will be removed.

Completing both the reuse entry and the free entry still results in only one (1) total entry.

4. Prize

One (1) grand prize of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000 USD, or the Canadian dollar equivalent for a Canadian winner, determined using the Bank of Canada daily exchange rate on the draw date), awarded as a single cash payment by cheque or electronic funds transfer, is available to be won. The prize will be disbursed within thirty (30) days of

verification of eligibility and completion of all required documentation. Total approximate retail value: \$10,000 USD. Prize is non-transferable and no substitution is offered except at the sponsor's sole discretion. All taxes and any expenses not specified here are the winner's responsibility.

5. Tax reporting

For a US winner, the sponsor will issue an IRS Form W-2G reporting the prize amount. The winner must provide a completed IRS Form W-9 before the prize will be disbursed. The sponsor may be required to withhold federal income tax at the applicable rate. All taxes and any related obligations are the sole responsibility of the winner.

6. Draw & odds

One winner will be selected in a random draw from all eligible entries at the end of the fall 2026 semester, on or about December 11, 2026, conducted by Reusables. Odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received.

7. Skill-testing question

As required by Canadian law, a selected entrant who is a Canadian resident must correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question (to be administered by telephone or by proctored video, as determined by Reusables) before being declared the winner. **This requirement applies regardless of whether the entrant qualified through the reuse entry or the free entry form.** If the selected entrant does not complete the requirement for the skill-testing question within the five (5) business days period referenced in paragraph 8 below, or answers incorrectly, they forfeit the prize and an alternate entrant will be drawn.

8. Winner notification

The selected entrant will be notified by phone call or SMS within three (3) business days of the draw, using the phone number on their Reusables account (for reuse entrants) or the phone number provided on their entry form (for free-entry entrants), and must confirm eligibility and sign and return a declaration and release (and where applicable a publicity release) within five (5) business days of being contacted by Reusables or its representative. Unclaimed prizes are forfeited and an alternate entrant randomly drawn from the remaining eligible entries, up to three attempts. If a winner cannot be confirmed after three attempts, Reusables may, in its sole discretion, decide not to award the prize. 9. General conditions

Reusables is not responsible for, (i) late, lost, delayed, not received, damaged, misdirected, incomplete, stolen, postage due or illegible entries; or (ii) failure to receive entries due to transmission failures or technical failures of any kind, including, without limitation, malfunctioning of any network, servers, access providers, hardware or software, whether originating with sender or recipient. Legitimate entries submitted through the normal entry process described in Section 3 are not subject to removal except as stated above. Personal information is handled per the Reusables privacy policy and used only to administer the draw. 10. Governing law

For entrants resident in the United States, this promotion is governed by the laws of the State of Delaware, without regard to conflict-of-law principles. For entrants resident in Canada, this promotion is governed by the laws of the Province of British Columbia and the federal laws of Canada applicable therein.
