Student user bridge, or SUB is a subscription based, user automation service that aids organisations to manage users and their access. Student User Bridge is our education version and helps schools manage access for their students and staff across their various education platforms.

How does it work?

SUB is an automation tool that we developed in-house to create and manage user and student access across multiple platforms. Your school can easily download your student's from vour management system (Such as Kamar, Hero, Etap, Edge etc.) and upload them into SUB. This process takes less than five minutes, and instructions are provided. Once uploaded, SUB will work its magic and users will be created, updated and removed where required. New students can be added in as soon as they are enrolled, to have all their accounts ready for their first day at school. Students no longer attending your school will also have all access and accounts removed to ensure good security. User's data is encrypted in transit and at rest. SUB is customisable and built to vour School's unique requirements.

What can it do?

Save Time – Automatically creates user accounts and removes the time-consuming process of manual user account creation and updates.

Streamline – SUB manages student and teacher accounts across multiple cloud platforms and enacts single sign on.
