What they needed

Parkhurst wanted to grow their heritage boot line. The boots had to look good in-store and comfortably in every environment.

What made it tough

Branding on leather details. Putting the pieces together had to be precise.

How we approached it

We sampled a leather material and boot samples. Their leather patch was tested a few times until the texture felt right. Once the patterns were set, we moved straight into production without any delays.

What came out of it

The 1,900 unit order finished in 14 days. The pieces handled their shop testing without issues and were added straight into their regular use.
