This program represents our commitment to building pathways to leadership and ensuring our community's voice is represented in the rooms where decisions are made.

About our First Cohort

El Camino Leadership Program – Building Napa Valley's Latino Leadership Pipeline

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- 9 leaders completed our Boards and Commissions leadership training through our pilot cohort
- 2 of the participants were selected to participate in Leadership Napa Valley
- \$6,000 in scholarship funds was provided to support these emerging leaders' professional development
- Strong partnerships were established with key community organizations for future Fellow placements and referrals
- Professional development sessions were delivered covering governance, fiduciary duty, equity in leadership, and strategic board service

Results:

Overall Impact:

- 100% found the content culturally relevant
- 75% rated their experience "Very Good" or "Excellent"
- 50% increased confidence to serve on boards/commissions
- 87.5% found facilitation inclusive and supportive

Future Engagement:

- 100% want ongoing mentorship/coaching
- 100% want a leadership alumni network
- 75% prefer quarterly meetings
- 62.5% will help recruit future participants
- 8 Total Participants
