We all have the potential to shift power and affect change in our communities. We encourage you to gather friends and family to discuss what changes you'd like to see for LGBTIQ+ displaced people in Australia and beyond, and how we can be part of that force for change.

Why this action is for you: If you want to increase visibility for LGBTIQ+ displaced people and inspire action with those around you – start the conversation.

Conversation Starters

1. What barriers are you aware of that LGBTIQ+ forcibly displaced people face trying to seek safety and protection?
2. Many people assume leaving a home country means someone is safe. What risks do LGBTIQ+ refugees often face in transit countries?
3. Less than 1% of philanthropic funding in the Asia–Pacific supports LGBTIQ+ migrants and refugees. What does this tell us about whose safety is prioritised, and whose is overlooked?
4. Resettlement as a solution is available to less than 1% of the world's forcibly displaced people. If resettlement is not always available or even the right way to seek asylum, what other solutions can we see?
5. When protection systems fail or become inaccessible, what role can communities and civil society play in helping people reach safety?
6. Why does it matter that responses to forced displacement are led by people with lived experience?
7. So often migrants have their identities flattened into the dimension of only safety-seeking and movement. How can we better embrace the full humanity of migrants in this country?
