Shield laws have expanded abortion access nationwide and helped protect providers delivering legally protected care across state lines. Telemedicine has become essential for patients living in reproductive healthcare deserts, allowing them to access evidence-based care without the burdens of travel, lost wages, or childcare costs. As attacks on medication abortion intensify, we must ensure patients can seek care safely and privately. That's why new protections, including legislation allowing patients and providers to use pseudonyms on prescription packaging, are emerging as a critical new front in the fight for reproductive freedom.
