

## **Register Your Product**

Register your Steadfast Storm Shelter tornado safe room to receive important benefits such as proof of ownership, product protection, and access to special offers. You will need the serial number found on the orange label inside the shelter.

## **Important Safety Information**

Your Steadfast Storm Shelter tornado safe room is engineered by professionals and rigorously tested to meet or exceed FEMA P-320 guidelines for residential and small-business storm shelters. It also complies with NSSA standards and carries its certification seal.

Although the shelter provides near-absolute protection from EF5 tornadoes and severe wind events, no structure can completely remove the risk of injury or death. Your safety is maximized when the shelter is used exactly as instructed.

## **Safety Guidelines**

- Do not use AC-powered appliances or any high-voltage devices during storms or when surfaces are wet.
- Be cautious when entering the shelter—rain and moisture can make the floor slippery.
- Always bring a mobile phone so you can call emergency services if debris blocks the exit. If you forget your phone, stay inside until the storm has passed and it is safe to leave.
- Use the shelter anytime a tornado watch or warning is issued by the National Weather Service.
- Keep basic supplies inside the shelter for comfort and safety during use.
- The safe room is not a play area and must not be used by children unsupervised.
- Keep the shelter locked when not in use, but store the key somewhere easy to access quickly during an emergency.
- Do not keep fuel, flammable liquids, or similar hazardous materials inside the shelter.
- Never use candles, lighters, or any open flame in the shelter.
- Make sure you are familiar with how the door opens and closes so you can operate it quickly in an emergency.
- Do not block or cover the ventilation openings while inside the shelter.
- Use only approved paints or coatings, as harmful fumes could build up and cause serious injury or death.
- Never try to exit through a door that is only partially open or obstructed by debris.
- Regularly check the shelter to ensure it is functioning properly and safe for use.
- The shelter is not designed for long-term living or extended occupancy.

## **Maintenance Instructions**

- Clean the safe room with a damp cloth and mild dish soap. Rinse and dry completely.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or solvents, as they can cause rust.
- Do not attempt any repairs yourself; the unit contains no user-serviceable parts. For guidance or repair assistance, call 334-777-6049.
- Ensure that water drains away from the shelter. Excess moisture buildup can damage the shelter and is not covered by the manufacturer's warranty.
