Additionally, the agent can qualify for incentives, bonuses, reward trips, and other compensation from BOSS, their insurance marketing organization, including AE, insurance companies, or related organizations based on insurance transactions. These incentives include, but are not limited to, trips, gifts, meals, entertainment, participation in bonus programs, reimbursement for training, marketing assistance, educational efforts, advertising, and travel expenses to conferences and events. We address these potential conflicts of interest by disclosing them through the ADV Part 2B brochure, other B.O.S.S. disclosures, following procedures, and the firm's fiduciary obligation to each client.
