WHAT DOES HYVE, INC. ("HYVE") DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income, credit scores, and debt information
- date of birth, address and phone number and email
- account balances and employment information, financial goals and employment info

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share **customers'** personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their **customers'** personal information; the reasons Hyve chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who we are

Who is providing this notice?

Hyve, Inc. and legal entities that utilize the name Hyve or Quinn (collectively "Hyve").

What we do

How does Hyve protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Access is limited only to Hyve employees who need it to do their work, and we require companies that work for us to protect your info as well.

How does Hyve collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Use Quinn or gives us your personal information
- Provide account info or create an account with us
- Create a financial plan with through Quinn.

We also collect your personal information from others, such as business partners, credit providers, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- Our affiliates include companies using the Hyve and name.

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- These can include financial service providers such as consumer banks, broker-dealers, and companies offering financial, investment, and credit products or services; or nonfinancial Fintechs, etc.

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- Our joint marketing partners include companies offering financial, investment, and credit products or services, including FinTechs.

Other important information

California, North Dakota and Vermont residents: We will not disclose your personal information, financial information or credit report to nonaffiliated third parties to market to you, other than as permitted by the laws of your state of residence, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures.
