Episode 1. Counting Down to Christmas – Celebrating ADVENT as a Catholic

14 minutes

What is Advent, anyway? A countdown to Christmas? Mini-Lent? Sweater season? An acceptable excuse to eat 24 tiny chocolates out of 24 tiny compartments?

In this episode of How to Advent, we learn about why Advent is a season of longing as well as hope – and how Advent calendars have anything to do with celebrating this season as a Catholic! As we await the birth of the Messiah, how can we better live in this spirit of hope and anticipation?

Episode 2. Catholic Guide to the Advent Wreath – Finding Purpose in the Waiting

12 minutes

The Advent wreath is an invitation to enter into the waiting and preparation for the birth of our Savior! As we explore the meaning of the Advent wreath – its light, colors, and components – we can better grasp how we should be preparing our hearts. As the light from the candles grows brighter and brighter throughout the four weeks of Advent, so too grows our longing for the coming Light of Christ.

Episode 3. The Jesse Tree EXPLAINED – The (Not) Christmas Tree You’ve Never Heard of

13 minutes

Everyone knows what a Christmas tree is. But have you heard of a Jesse tree?

The often-forgotten Jesse tree reminds us of God’s faithful fulfillment of all his promises (of which there are so many throughout all of salvation history!). In Christ, he keeps every promise he has made, from Adam and Eve to John the Baptist. His promises of peace and salvation apply not just to ancient Israel, but to all of us today. Join us in learning about this hidden gem of an Advent tradition and how it can help you and your family walk through Advent in the light of Sacred Scripture.

Episode 4. There's More to Your Nativity Scene than You Thought

17 minutes

When you really think about the nativity scene – it's kind of a shocking story. But if our Lord didn't hesitate to be born among donkeys and hay, why would he hesitate to involve himself in the mess of our daily lives? In Bethlehem, Jesus entered fully into our messy, cold, dark world. He wasn't embarrassed to enter into our poverty. In this episode, we explore the incarnational meaning of the nativity set, traditions to follow within your own family, and how we're not only preparing for the birth of Christ that happened 2000 years ago – but the present reality that Christ will one day come again for us. Are you ready?

This famous painting reveals the Christ Child as the light that has come into the world and also depicts the Blessed Mother, St. Joseph, and the shepherds to be models of adoration to our humble Lord who came as a helpless baby.
