Vincent Boussez

Exploring through photography the untouched vastness of our planet and the interplay of scale and perspective, Vincent Boussez reminds us – as we often forget – that on the scale of the Universe we are “infinitely small” and on the scale of Time a “mere snap of the fingers”.

A self-taught artist, and a career stretching back 20 years, Vincent has been inspired by the surrealism of French photographer Gilbert Garcin and Ron Muek’s hyper-realistic sculptures and poignant use of scale.

With his series Plastic Life, Vincent made his name by initiating a veritable photographic movement, with the creation of scenes featuring human figurines placed at the heart of daily life, to achieve a delicate balance between humour and social criticism.

The artist then left his studio, travelling to lose himself, and his viewers, in the remote regions of the Far North, inside the Arctic Circle.

The geography of these isolated places allows him to play with scale and perspective in a different way. In these latest works, he reminds us indirectly of the current human condition: that the more we grow in number, and the more we expand, the more it costs the world around us.

Here, Vincent Boussez breaks with scale to create a testimony to the virgin territories of our planet, paying homage to nature and the fragile world around us, while exploring the relationships and tensions between isolation, destruction, expansion and exploration.
