EMIS Logon Guide

Introduction

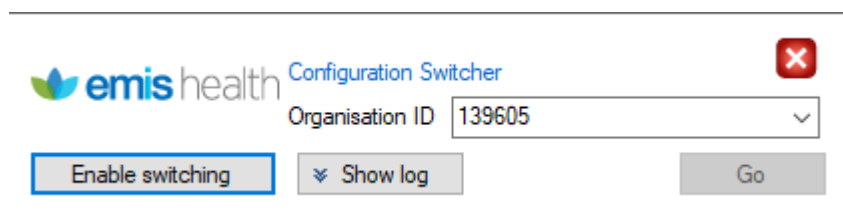
In order to log on to different EMIS systems from a single computer it is necessary to use something called Configuration Switcher. This is an integral part of the EMIS software so as long as the EMIS Web client is installed then Configuration Switcher will be installed already. The switcher ensures that the relevant version files are present on the local computer for each EMIS Web system being used.

If Configuration Switcher is not activated and used then you may experience problems logging in and using certain aspects of EMIS, particularly prescribing.

Configuration Switcher

If you click the EMIS Web icon and are presented with a login details box immediately then Configuration Switcher is not active. Cancel the login box and follow the guide below to enable switcher.

Click the Windows Start button, click All Programs, click the EMIS folder, click Configuration Switcher. When the switcher loads, click the button that says Enable Switching (see below).



The button will change to say Disable Switching. Enter the Organisation ID (CDB) number for the system you want to logon to and click Go. The CDB for extended access is 139605.

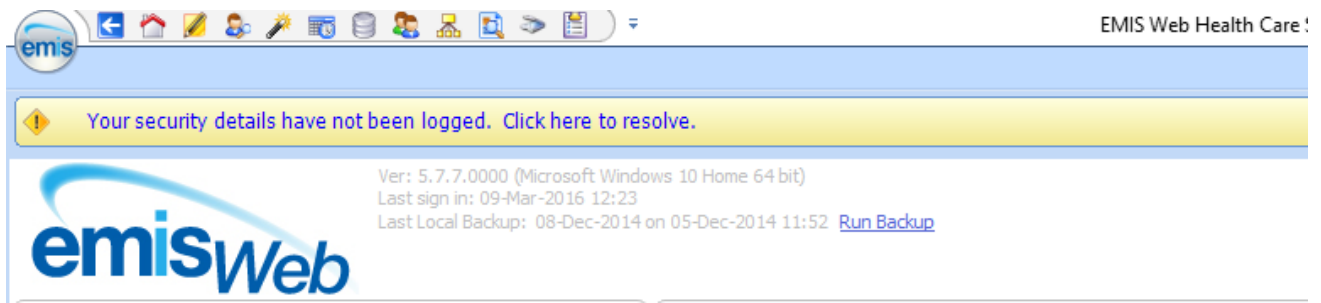
Setting up your security details

The first time you logon to the extended access EMIS system it is important that you set up your security details as this will allow you to reset your password in the event that you forget it.

If you didn't do this at first logon then you will be prompted with a yellow message bar each time you log in. If you see this bar, please click it and set up your security details.

Complete your details and click Save. These details are stored securely by EMIS and are not used for any other purpose than to reset your password.

We only use the mobile number to send you a verification code, so that you can log in if you have forgotten your password or need reminding of your user name. We encrypt this number and all other security details and will never share any security details with any other organisation or person.
