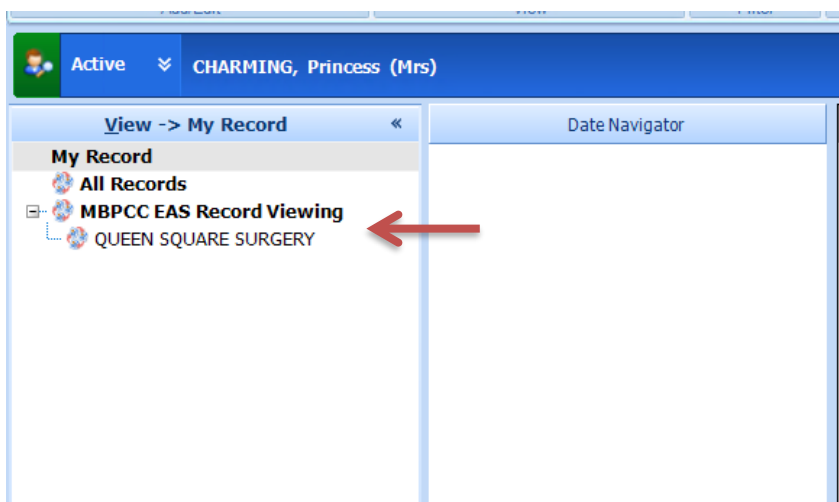
Introduction

These instructions apply to both practices wishing to view data entered by their Federation extended access services, and for Federations wishing to view the practice held record.

Viewing Records

Load the patient.

On the left hand side of your screen it will identify any sharing agreements in place (red arrow).



Click to expand *MBPCC EAS Record Viewing* to see which other records are available to view. Click on the organisation record that you want to view (red arrow). Alternatively you can click *All Records* which will show you the local and shared records all in one view.

Data from a shared record will have a blue and red symbol at the right hand side. Hovering over this symbol will tell you which record the data is from.
