Return to Practice Nurse Placements

The University of Lancashire is offering a **Return to Practice course dedicated to General Practice Nursing** and encourages Practices in Lancashire and South Cumbria to provide **clinical placements** for participants.

The students on this course are experienced nurses who are looking for a General Practice Nurse role. Providing a placement is a wonderful opportunity for Practices to support their education as well as to build a relationship with a dedicated and enthusiastic future GP nurse.

Practices receive a tariff of £500 for the placement. Students are required to complete a minimum of 100 hours in placement and require a sign-off mentor.
