

# Host a Meet & Greet for Bobby Charles

#### 1. Pick Your Format

- Living room, backyard, garage, local café, VFW hall whatever fits 10—
  20 people comfortably.
- Keep it casual. These events aren't fancy; they're about authentic conversations.

#### 2. Choose a Date & Time

- Evenings between 6–8 PM or weekend mornings perform best.
- Aim for 60 minutes max. Short, high-impact.

### 3. Invite Your Network

- Family, friends, neighbors, church groups, sports leagues, local business owners.
- Send a simple message: "I'm hosting a small gathering to talk about fixing Maine and supporting Bobby Charles. Want to come?"

## 4. Confirm With the Campaign

- Email: [CAMPAIGN EMAIL]
- Share: date, time, expected headcount, location.
- We'll provide talking points, handouts, and digital materials.

## 5. Keep It Simple

- Light snacks or coffee are enough.
- Set out a sign-in sheet or tablet for collecting names, emails, zip codes.

### 6. Run the Event

You don't need to "present." Just guide the room.

- Welcome everyone
- Share why you support Bobby
- Show a quick video or read a short bio
- Open discussion: let people speak
- End with one clear action: Donate, Volunteer, or Follow on Social

### 7. Follow Up

- Send attendees a thank-you text.
- Ask them to take one small action (share a post, sign up as a volunteer, donate).
- Send the sign-in sheet to the campaign.
