## THE MISSION

## 1. NO NONSENSE IN SCHOOLS

### 3. NO NONSENSE IN HEALTHCARE

Governor Mills just put \$2.25 million of your tax dollars into a budget backfill for Planned Parenthood. Parents make medical decisions for their children, not the state. And I will redirect those dollars where they belong: rural healthcare, nursing homes, and senior prescription coverage.

### 4. END THE CORRUPTION IN AUGUSTA

Maine's own Democratic state auditor found over \$1.6 billion in contracts processed while ignoring the state's own rules. The Bangor Daily News quietly received \$2.4 million in state contracts under Mills, none disclosed to readers. A Soros-backed media outlet got \$117,300 via a no-bid contract. When Mills took office the budget was \$8.9 billion. It's now nearly \$12 billion. Where did it all go? On Day One I will establish an Independent Accountability Task Force, end no-bid contracts, and make the findings public.
