## **1.0 Roundtable check-in and updates on communities impacted by the flooding**

Each community had their challenges surrounding communication/alerts with local governments, community members, misinformation, dealing with insurance coverage details, travel, and flooded community homes.

Recommendation: On-line communication should be consistent with accurate documentation.

**Action 01:** Chief David Jimmie to work with Emergency Management of BC (EMBC) and Tyrone McNeil of the First Nations Education Steering Committee (FNESC) to develop a one-pager with a regional approach for communities on a communication process in the event of an emergency.

## **2.0 Properties Information Package review and discussion**

The main goal is to obtain Coqualeetza Additions to Reserve (ATR). And then ask the 21 bands about their familiarity and knowledge of each of the properties and their uses.

The plan is to come together and use the “collective and open door” approach on what the communities see for the properties present and future uses. There will be many details to go over such as administration, management, finances, leases, and outstanding debt.

Recommendation: Chief David Jimmie to provide key message points to be used when presenting the Properties Information Package to the bands, so that the SNCC leadership is providing consistent information.

## **3.0 First Nations Health Council (FNHC) – Funding Discussion at SNCC and Collective Meeting at Matsqui First Nation on January 12, 2022**

Chief Derek Epp requested to table the topic of health funding inadequacies and how to work to reclaim some of those funds back to communities (outside of the agenda) Chief Epp suggested getting the SNCC political support.
