Tasting Note An expressive nose with bright citrus and stonefruit aromas combining with hints of subtle, spicy oak. Palate is ripe and textural, bright fruit balanced by acidity and toasty notes from lees ageing and a small proportion of barrel fermented wine

Table Talk Curated in the usual Wild House fashion, 'lazy winemaking' as JD calls it. The grapes, from a single vineyard in Paarl, are gently crushed and naturally fermented, with no additions. 80 % in tank, 20% in older French oak barrels.
