

Local Poem of the Month: Guidelines

Eligibility:

- Ages 15 and up
- Poets must reside, full or part-time, on the Cape or Islands. You **do not** have to be a Brewster resident in order to submit.
- Both previously-published poets and unpublished poets are eligible.
- You **do not** have to have a Brewster Ladies' Library card in order to submit work.

Directions on Submission Process:

- Each poet may only submit **one poem per year**.
- Poems must be able to fit on one regular 8 ½" x 11" sheet of paper. They may be single or double spaced, but **should not exceed 25 lines**. Please use a standard 12 pt. font.
- All poems, whether previously published or never-before published, are acceptable.
- You may also include a brief bio and a photo of yourself to be displayed in the library alongside your poem, but these are not requirements for submission.
- There is no submission fee.
- Submissions will be accepted **year-round** on an ongoing basis.
- Please note that submitted poems will not be returned, so retain a copy of your work.
- **How to submit:** Email your poem as an attachment to ggriffis@brewsterladieslibrary.org with "Poetry Submission" in the subject line. If you wish to include a bio and photo for display, please include them as a separate attachment in the same email. If you would prefer to submit a hard copy of your poem, you may drop it off at the library in an envelope labeled "Poetry Submission," or you can mail your submission to:
