

INFIRMARY – RULES (SUMMARY)

Operating hours: 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m., with a 24-hour ambulance available for emergencies.

Service provided to members and dependents; guests are attended only in emergencies.

Priority is given to seniors, pregnant women, children, and people with special needs.

Services include: first aid, medical emergencies, dressings, immediate medication, medical certificates, and triage.

Medications are not provided to take home.

Minors must be accompanied by a guardian. Only one companion per patient is allowed.

Eating or drinking in the infirmary is prohibited, except with medical authorization.

Cell phones must remain on silent mode; filming or recording without authorization is prohibited.

All medical records are confidential and stored for five years.

The facility is accessible to people with disabilities and includes observation areas.

Club employees may use the infirmary in case of workplace accidents and participate in first aid training.

Inappropriate behavior may result in immediate removal from the premises.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in sanctions as stated in the Club's internal regulations.
