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CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

We are happy to report on another busy year in the work of the Board, Management and Staff of the Samoa Fire and Emergency Services Authority. The Authority experienced a high volume of emergency call outs for the year particularly with its ambulance response services. A new One Emergency number "911" for all of Samoa was established as a separate National Emergency Call Centre (NECC) through a Cabinet Directive. This formed part of the services delivered by the Authority commencing 1 January 2018. FESA also received two new specialized fire fighting vehicles, a ladder truck and a 3,000ltr tanker donated by the Government of Japan through its 2015 Grant Aid Scheme.

ACTIVITIES AND PERFORMANCE OF THE AUTHORITY

Financial Performance:

The Authority continues to be in a healthy financial position with a net surplus of \$815,299.00 recorded at the end of the financial year which is attributable to several factors. Personnel Budget for upgraded positions was not fully utilized until the middle of the year due to a new recruitment and selection process enforced by the Authority for every rank on the Organisational Structure. Furthermore, Operational spending was controlled within their budgetary limits although at times this proved challenging given the nature of the Authority's work. This surplus is earmarked for one major project that will be carried out in the new financial year. There was a notable increase in the Grant from the Government of Samoa for recruitment of 35 additional and new staff including staff to man the new 911 NECC as well as other developments for the building to accommodate additional staff members.

Operational Performance:

The work of the Fire Suppression and Emergency Response Department continues to prove vital for the people of Samoa. Whilst there were no major structural fire incidences in the year, there were nevertheless increased emergency response services provided for the people of Samoa at 929 compared to 288 in the previous financial year. It is noteworthy to consider the increased role of the ambulance response services provided by the Authority which grew by 222% compared to the previous year. This steady growth reflects the effectiveness of the single Emergency Number 911 established in January 2018 where members of the public are no longer confused on the numbers to call in times of emergencies.

We are pleased to report that our Fire Safety team continues to provide proactive awareness programs to schools and communities both in the rural and urban areas in our drive to raise the awareness of our people to reduce the likelihood of fire and other emergencies from occurring.

Developments & Future Outlook:

The Authority continues to strive for the delivery of best emergency response services as mandated in our mission statement. Capacity building and up skilling of staff to provide emergency response services continues to be the main focus of the Authority and as seen with the trend of response services undertaken in the past 12 months, there is always the need to build the capacity of the staff to provide varied response services in times of emergencies.

Over the past several years, the Authority has experienced increased incidences in the Western Coastal area and to ensure that we provide timely and effective response services to residents of this area, the Authority has moved to secure a 3-acre plot of land at Faleolo from the Samoa Trust Estates Corporation. It is anticipated that a new fire station will be built in the next few years which will cater for the residents around the Western side of Upolu. The Authority was also fortunate to secure five second-hand response trucks from JICA for this new station which will all be delivered in the new financial year. In addition to this proposed new Fire Station, it is also anticipated that a new Mechanical Workshop will be built in the new financial year.

Directors Information:

The Authority also bid farewell to one of its long serving Board member, Hon. Hans Joachim Joe Keil who resigned from his position as one of the independent Board Members due to health problems.

The Board continues to uphold corporate governance to ensure that the Authority serves the best interest of the people of Samoa. The Board held 12 meetings during the year with Directors attendance highlighted below:

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

I am pleased to once again report on another challenging but successful year for the Fire and Emergency Services Authority (SFESA). The SFESA Board and staff have worked hard to improve the services provided by the Authority to the people of Samoa and particularly with the commencement of the NECC.

HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE YEAR

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS:

i. Regional Recognition

SFESA Commissioner was elected as one of the Executive Member of the Pacific Islands Fire and Emergency Services Association (PIFESA) during the Australasian Fire and Emergency Services Authority Council (AFAC) and Pacific Islands Emergency Management Alliance (PIEMA) week held in Sydney, Australia. The election of the SFESA Commissioner as an Executive Member of PIFESA recognizes the advocacy role of the Authority within the region, more so with projects involving PIEMA and the South Pacific Community (SPC).

ii. Staff Capacity Building & Development

The Authority secured the services of an Australian Paramedic Volunteer, Ms. Krystelle Syme through the Australian Volunteer for International Development (AVID) and the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) for one year. This was crucial for SFESA given its increasing ambulance services call outs. Ms. Syme has been instrumental in building the capacities of the Operational Staff in the delivery of its ambulance services particularly in pre-hospital care and basic first aid. We anticipate that Ms. Syme will be able to continue in the new financial year as her services are vital in building this crucial arm of the Authority's operational work.

The Assistant Commissioner (AC) Safety and Prevention, pioneered a Fire Investigation Analysis (FIA) Training undertaken in Melbourne at the Metropolitan Fire Brigade (MFB) for 10 weeks with financial assistance from SPC under the 'Building Safety and Resilience in the Pacific' (BSRP) Project. The successful return of the AC from this important secondment assists the Authority to undertake Fire Investigation Analysis locally, particularly for large scale fire incidences without the Government having to rely on experts from overseas to provide this crucial service. He will be responsible for building the capacity of the Fire Safety Staff to undertake these specialized skills in the New Year

There is also the partnership between JICA and the Authority in which an Operational staff members was trained in Japan for 2 months to study Search and Rescue Operations which is another vital area of the Operations work. We expect that this program will continue in the next few years to enhance skills set of the staff to undertake this area of response services.

Thirty eight (38) staff graduated in two Promotional Ceremonies in both Upolu and Savaii following a reinvigorated and strenuous recruitment and selection process. These positions were approved for recruitment in the Authority's 2017-2018 Financial Year Budget.

iii. New Services Offered by the Authority

Cabinet approved the establishment of a National Emergency Call Centre (NECC) within the Authority for a One Emergency Number “911” which officially commenced operations on 1 January 2018. The NECC has a full operational staff of 13. This has been one of the success stories of the year with increasing numbers of calls recorded every month since the commencement of operations with less confusion amongst the members of the Public as to the numbers to call in times of emergencies.

Parliament in January 2018 passed an Amendment to the SFESA Act 2007 to legislate the performance of hot works within the country. The Amendment authorizes FESA to issue permits for prescribed hot works operations as well as imposing penalties for non-compliance with conditions of permits issued. This is an indication of the increased role of the Authority to monitor fire safety regulations in work places and is a new service that is now undertaken by Fire Safety Staff.

iv. Donated Funds and Equipment Received by the Authority:

SFESA was very fortunate to receive 2 Donated Specialized Fire Fighting trucks from the Government of Japan as part of its assistance under its Grant Aid Program for the Economic and Social Development for Samoa, 2015 funding. The Specialized Trucks include an Aerial Ladder Truck and a Pumper Truck and will enhance fire suppression services provided by the Authority particularly for high rise buildings within the Apia Township and the Vaitele Industrial area. The combined cost of both vehicles is estimated at WST1.9 million.

The Government of Samoa through the Authority’s 2017-2018 Financial Year Budget funded a Toyota fully-equipped Land Cruiser Ambulance valued at WST274,000.00. The ambulance vehicle has assisted tremendously with the response services provided by the Authority to emergency victims and patients.

The Accident Compensation Corporation approved a proposal by the Authority for the procurement of two ambulance vehicles and one Hiace Van to assist with the ambulance services. The new vehicles are expected to be received in the new financial year.

SFESA received a donation of SAT15,258.41 and a 6GB HDD from families and friends from St. George Utah, USA and were earmarked for the development of the NECC.

v. Celebrated Milestones:

International Fire Fighters Day was celebrated on 4 May with the theme for this year being “**Serve with Honour, Commitment and Sacrifice**”. This special event celebrates the selfless services, commitment and sacrifices made by fire fighting men and women around the world in performing their duties and responsibilities. A targeted 5 primary and 5 secondary schools were selected to be a part of this celebrated event with the year’s celebration focused on building awareness within schools of the Authority’s work to assist in reducing fire and other incidences.

Management had also undertaken an assessment of the SFESA Act 2007 with a proposal referred to the Office of the Attorney General for a full review to address gaps and to incorporate other services offered by the Authority such as the National Emergency Call Centre. The review should be finalised within the next two years.

A new Corporate Plan (CP) for the Year 2019.2021 was approved by the Board which sets out challenging goals and strategies for the staff to achieve at the end of the CP period. The new CP reflects the Authority's push for each of the four Departments to be fully responsible for its goals and strategies and to enforce the achievement of its respective Key Performance Indicators.

The Authority's Search and Rescue Facility (SAR) funded by SPC under the Building Safety and Resilience in the Pacific (BSRP) Project commenced construction in April 2018 and is expected to be completed in December 2018. Over the past several years, the Authority has sought financial assistance from several potential development partners to finance a SAR Facility and we have been fortunate that SPC has been instrumental in securing a donor funding under one of its current ongoing project.

Samoa Land Corporation (SLC) approved an additional half acre land extending the current leasehold land at Faleata in which the Faleata Fire Station is located. This was a result of years of negotiation to extend the Authority's land area for its future developments.

FESA was a crucial member of the Committee for the Celebration of Samoa's 56 Years of Independence of which the Commissioner was the Chairman of the Fa'afiafiaga and Fa'aaloaloga Committee. The Fire Safety and Operations Department staff played essential roles in monitoring of stalls to ensure safety requirements were upheld and observed by all operators to safeguard members of the public and stall operators.

vi. Major Operations:

There were no major operations or incidences that occurred during the year except for Tropical Cyclone Gita which struck Samoa in February 2018. The Authority utilized all off-duty staff and volunteers and exhausted its available resources to ensure that it was able to provide rescue operations during the cyclone as well as recovery work for families that were affected.

The Board, Management and staff bid farewell to one of its senior member who passed away due to an illness. Commander Tamala held the position of Commander for the two Fire Stations in Savaii when he passed away. We commend the work that he did to oversee the Savaii staff.

OVERVIEW OF OPERATING PERFORMANCE AND RESULTS

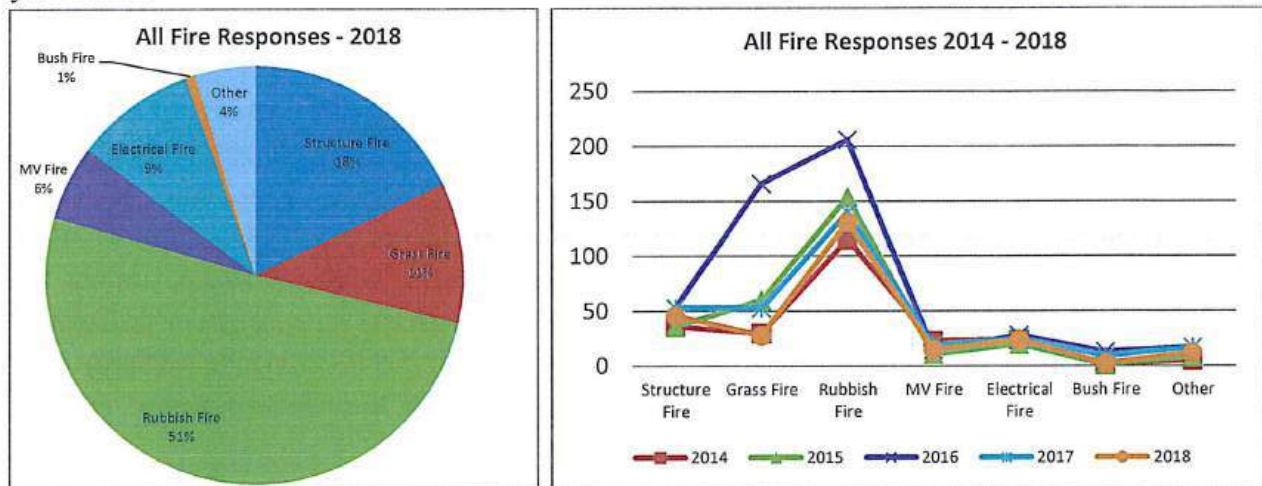
1. FIRE SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (OPERATIONS)

The Fire Suppression and Emergency Response Department holds the core functions of ensuring the efficient and effective fire and emergency service which is responsive to the needs of the public. It also includes the Training Division responsible for Technical and Physical Training of the Staff as well as the Mechanical Division responsible for maintenance of all Authority Vehicle.

1.1 Fire Suppression

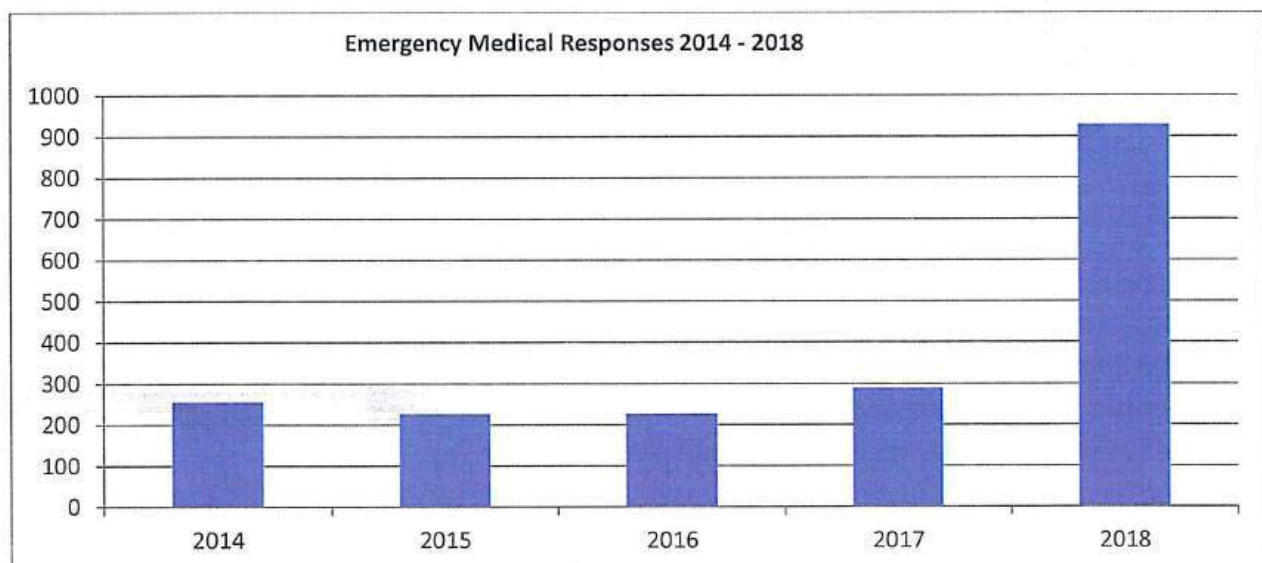
For the year ending June 2018, the Authority responded to a total number of 258 fire incidences which decreased by 18.35% compared to 316 in the previous financial year. The decrease is mainly due to substantial reductions in the bush, grass and structural fire categories by 78%, 47% and 13%

respectively and also correlate to the fluctuating wet weather patterns experienced by the country all year round.



1.2 Ambulance Service: Emergency Medical Response

Despite the notable reductions in the three categories of fire noted for this financial year, the Emergency Medical Responses provided by the Authority's ambulance crew increased by a record 222% to 929 call outs compared to 288 call outs in the previous year. This substantial increase is attributable to the established Emergency Number 911 which commenced operations in January 2018. The establishment of the Emergency Number ensured that there was minimal confusion amongst members of the public when requiring the assistance of the ambulance and with the NHS confining their services to hospital-to-hospital transfers only, the Authority was obligated to receive all emergency medical call outs.

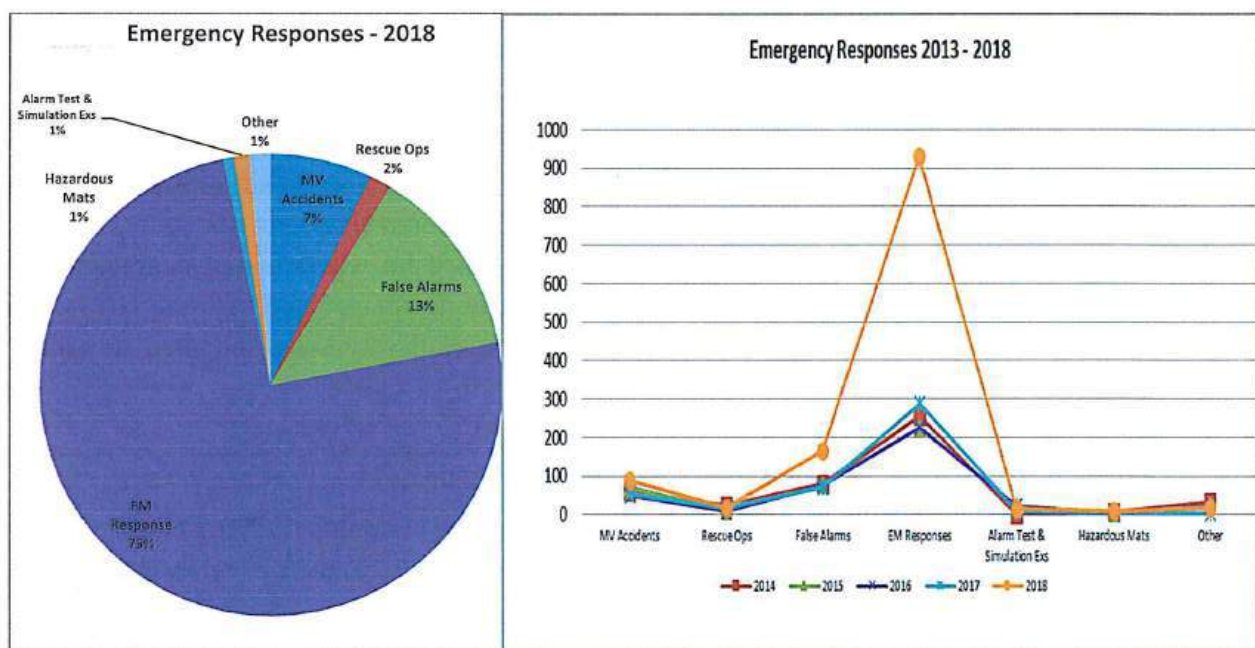


1.3 Other Emergency Responses:

Total Emergency Responses inclusive of Medical Responses increased by a record 1,244 which is an increase of 180% from 445 in the previous year. In addition to the 222% increase in Emergency

Medical Response, Hazardous Material Responses increased by 200%. False Alarms that the Authority responded-to, increased by 135% from 71 in the previous year to 167 for this financial year whilst Motor Vehicle Accidents rising also by 63% to 88 call outs compared to 54 call outs in the previous year.

There is an increasing trend of other emergencies that the Authority is required to respond to and for this financial year, there has been a substantial increase in False Alarms that the Authority is required to attend to. Management is looking at strengthening its processes and procedures to effectively manage this area by holding property owners accountable for non-compliance. Motor Vehicle Accidents responses show an alarming increase in responses with an average of seven accident call out per month. Responses to Hazardous Materials also significantly increased and the Authority continues to pro-actively build the capacity of its Operational personnel to undertake rescue and response services for these types of emergencies.



1.4 Training Division:

The Operations Department continues to conduct twice-weekly personal trainings and quarterly required fitness level trainings for its staff to ensure that Operational staff members are well-equipped to conduct monthly joint-trainings with its volunteer members. The following specialized trainings were conducted for the year for Operational Staff:

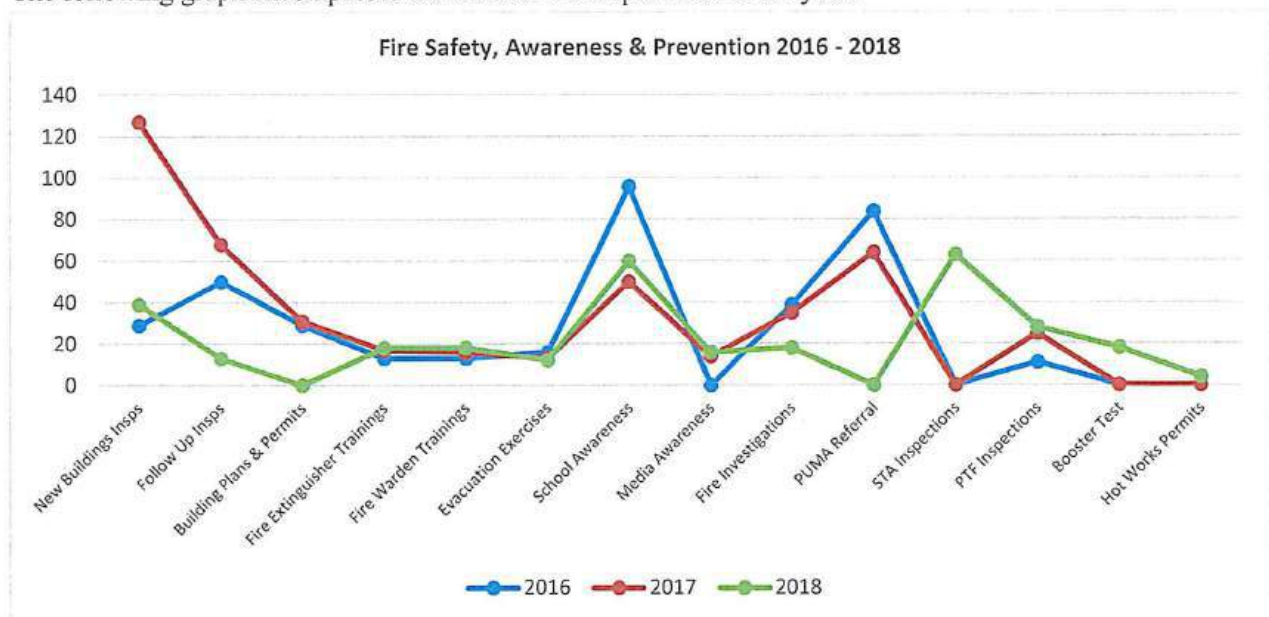
- Quarterly Required Fitness Level Trainings & Tests
- Twice a Week Personal Trainings
- One Advanced Training for Firefighting on Ships and Ferries
- Eight CDCRM Drills and Exercises in conjunction with ADRA and DMO
- Ongoing Shift Trainings for capacity building of operational staff

2. FIRE SAFETY, AWARENESS & PREVENTION SERVICES:

The Fire Safety, Awareness and Prevention Services Department (FSAPD) play a significant role in the Authority's mandate to oversee compliancy with Fire Safety laws, ensure prevention of emergencies through pro-active awareness programs and enforcing the FESA Act 2007.

2.1 Additional New Service:

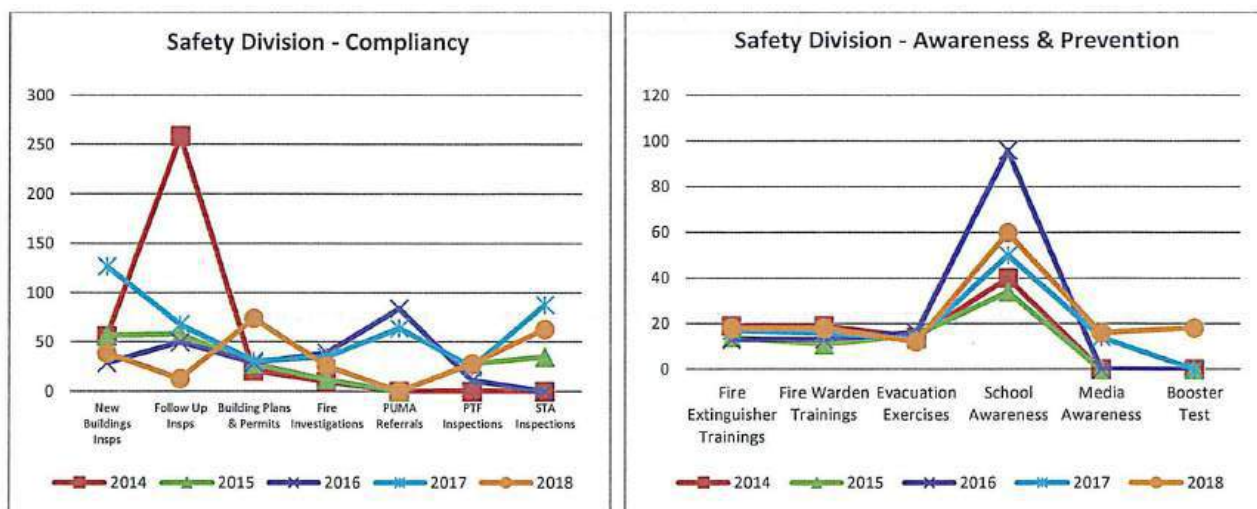
The 2018 year proved to be a tough year for the FSAPD with increased core Key Performance Indicators to be achieved with no additional man power recruited to perform the essential services mandated under the Department. The Hot Works Permit law passed by Parliament during the year was enforced by Fire Safety in which focus was concentrated on Commercial Operators after the amendment was passed. It is anticipated that awareness for this new process will be conducted in the next financial year as we look to enforce the law with all Hot Works operators including small business operators and sole traders. The following graph encompasses the work of the Department in the year.



2.2 Compliance:

One of the two core functions of the Department enforces compliancy with Fire Safety legislations. For the year, there were notable reductions in new building inspections, follow up inspections and fire investigation analysis by 70%, 81% and 26% as a result of limited staff to undertake the work whilst additional responsibilities were required to be undertaken by the existing staff. The role of the Authority also with the Petroleum Task Force (PTF) and the Samoa Tourism Accommodations Standards Committee (STASC) continue to provide the crucial platform where FESA advocates and pushes for fire and general safety within these premises and businesses for both employees and customers.

PTF Inspection both increased by 12% STASC Inspections decreased by 28% due to the prioritized needs of the STA. It is the Department's focus to utilize these mediums to enforce compliance of owners and operators with the relevant laws and regulations for safety for all users.



2.3 Awareness and Prevention:

The second core function of the Department focuses on Prevention and Awareness campaigns to schools, communities and work places. Prevention targets technical trainings provided for Fire Wardens (FW) for multi-storey buildings and for businesses within the Apia Township, Vaitele Industrial Area and prominent hotels and resorts. An increase of 13% was noted for FW Trainings compared to last year. Fire Extinguisher Trainings are also provided for businesses for effective use of these fire equipment, which slightly increased to 6% from the previous year. Additionally, Booster Testing have also commenced for high rise and multi-storey buildings to ensure that internal fire systems within these buildings are working properly to combat a possible fire incident within the premises. Booster Testing for the year increased by 100% compared to the previous year. Another work of the prevention programs target Community Evacuation exercises in which FESA partners with other Core Agencies like DMO and ADRA to prepare villages and communities around the country for any disaster or major emergency that occurs. Community Evacuation decreased by 7% compared to the previous year due to reduced exercises conducted by DMO.

Awareness Campaigns dominantly used by the Authority include the use of Billboards erected around Upolu and Savaii and all Billboards were renewed to address the one emergency number used by the country commencing January 2018. School awareness campaigns increased by 20% compared to the previous year as the Department concentrated its efforts in rural primary and secondary schools in both Islands to raise students' awareness of fire prevention and fire safety. We continue to place considerable importance on this area of Fire Safety work as we strive to train our children on the significance of preventing fire staying safe. Media Campaigns utilizing the TV and radio have also form part of our drive for safety message to reach our other audiences which increased by 14% compared to the previous year. We acknowledge the support provided by the Accident Compensation Corporation, whose financial assistance makes it possible for the Authority to provide its awareness campaigns to rural schools and communities.

3 CORPORATE SERVICES DEPARTMENT:

The Corporate Services Department (CSD) is charged with providing continuous administration and technical support as well as maintaining and providing accurate and transparent financial information for the efficient and effective operation of the Authority. There are four Divisions within the CSD that implements these core objectives, Communications, Information and Technology, Human Resource and Finance.

3.1 Communications Division:

The Communications Division continues to play an important role in ensuring that the communication network is running with minimal problems and disruptions. This is crucial as in times of any incidents or major emergencies, the Communications Division is charged with monitoring and controlling of the communication systems and devises to ensure ease of communication. In March 2018, TC Gita struck Samoa and as a result, 60% of the Emergency Radio Network (ERN) was reported damaged on both islands. SFESA with technicians from the Ministry of Police and the Disaster Management Office worked to restore connectivity in the months following the Cyclone. During the year, the NECC was officially transferred under the Division and now forms part of the Communications Team.

The NECC 911 Emergency Number was approved by the Board to be under the Communication Division and is located at the Faleata Fire Station. Functions of the NECC as approved by the Cabinet include the receiving and dispatching of all emergency calls to the relevant responding agency. The initiative for a one emergency number was made by Cabinet in an effort to address the confusion that the public had with three emergency numbers that operated previously for the Police, Ambulance Services and the Fire Services and operates 24/7.

3.2 Information and Technology:

Information and Technology (IT) has developed over the last 12 months with the recruitment of a Principal IT Officer to oversee the division and its support services provided for the Authority. There is improvement in the IT systems and equipment used by the Authority to keep up with technological changes that affect its response services with better internet connectivity and an email server which is now housed internally. The Authority has secured a Server which serves to manage the active directory, file management and antivirus software management. We anticipate bigger and better results from the IT Division in future.

3.3 Human Resource Division:

The Human Resource Division has been fully stretched to undertake HR work in addition to Strategic Planning and Policy work at the same time. Whilst this has proven a challenge at times, we have managed to achieve many of our goals and targets that were set to be achieved in the year. The Authority for the first time managed to produce an Annual Plan setting annual goals and targets for 2018 and HR Division has been instrumental for production of this milestone and have also been monitoring the progress of achievement. A full review of the 2018 will be conducted in the new financial year.

Two promotional ceremonies were held both in Savaii and Upolu for staff that were put through a stringent recruitment and selection process adopted in the previous year to select the best applicants for various vacant positions. This was a milestone as FESA had not held promotions for its staff over the past couple of years considering Operational and Fire Safety staff are selected from within the service.

One major work that the HR Division focused on for the year was a complete overhaul of the existing 2016 Terms and Conditions of Employment with the first draft endorsed by the Board in April 2018. We anticipate that the revised HR Manual to replace the 2016 Terms and Conditions of Employment will be approved by the Board and commence operations in the new financial year.

HR continues to build the capacity of the staff through the provision of in-house management and generic trainings as well as actively seeking opportunities for staff to be exposed to training opportunities in-country and out of country. The following are some of the attachments that the staff attended for the year:

3.4 Finance

The Finance Division of the Authority is responsible for its financial performance and results which are highlighted in this report:

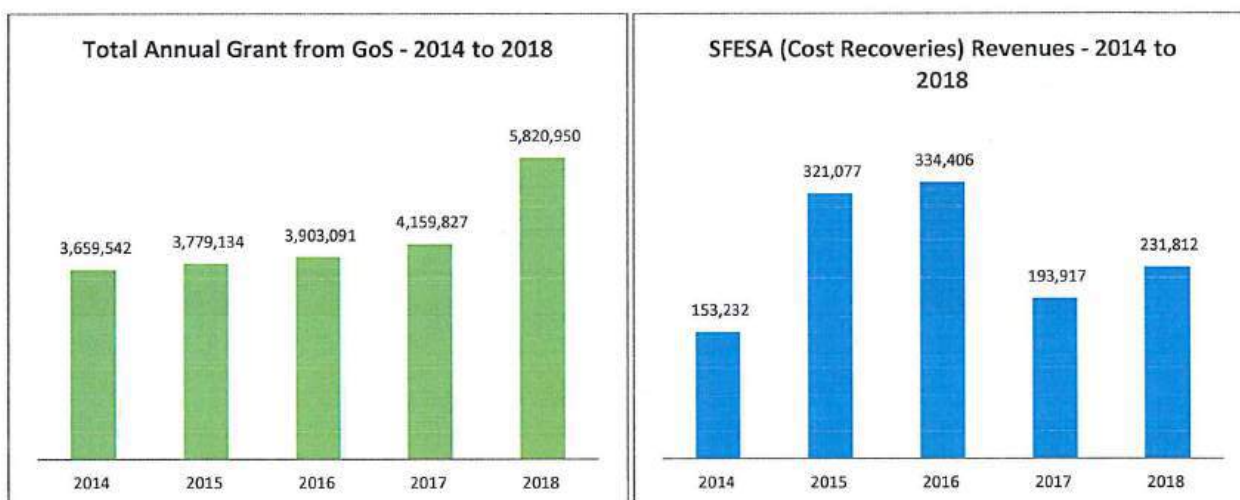
OVERVIEW OF FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE AND RESULTS

Government Grant:

The Government of Samoa's annual grant to the Authority totaled \$5.8 million which is an increase of 41.5% from the previous year's budget of \$4.1million with the majority of this increase for the purpose of recruitment of more staff to provide the increased response services and to procure a new ambulance vehicle.

Cost Recoveries (Revenues):

Our revenue collection for the year increased by 19.5% or \$37,895 to \$231,812 compared to the previous year. We exceeded our budgeted Cost Recoveries (revenues) by 48% or \$75,299 at the end of the financial year through reinforcing our processes and procedures with the issuance of building plans, collecting of 1% insurance fire levies and proactive collection of our false alarm debtors. We anticipate a more proactive approach in the new financial year to ensure that our revenue streams are targeted for higher collections to assist with future developments.



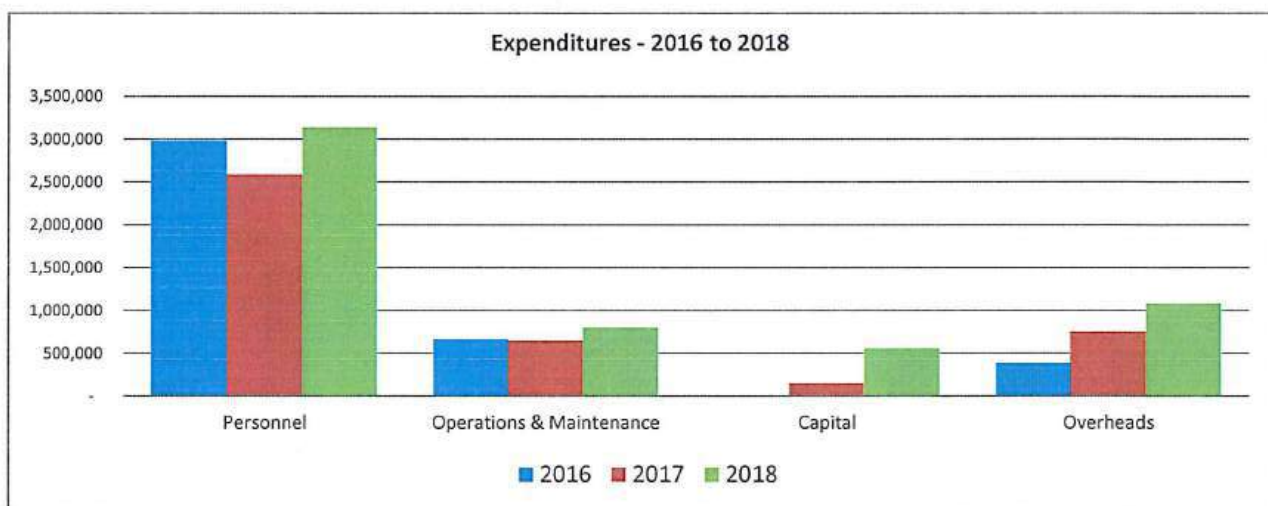

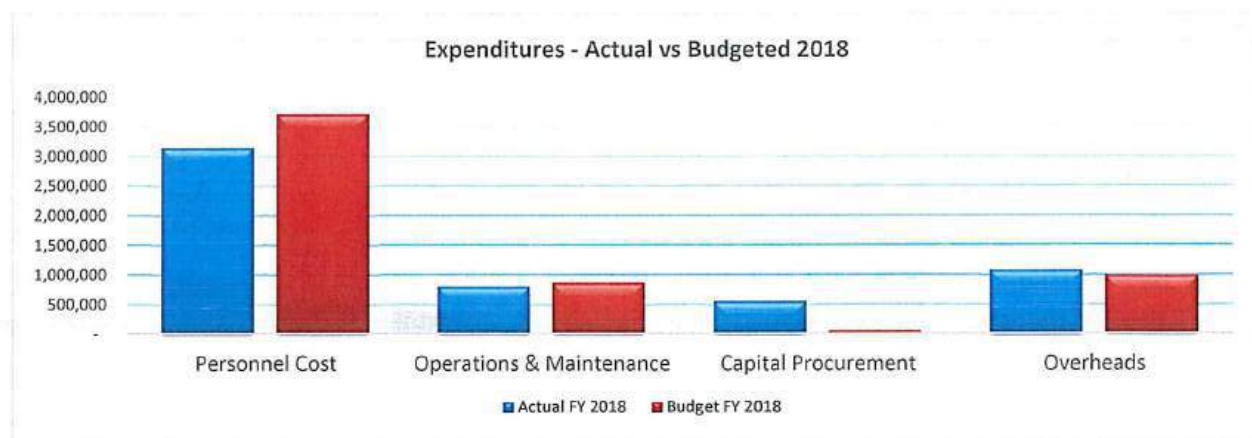
Expenditures:

Capital and Overhead expenditures exceeded their budgeted targets due to the extension to the main office building in Apia and the repairs and renovations undertaken at Faleata Station to house the NECC. Both these costs overrun were not factored in for the 2018 budget as this was a Cabinet Directive (FK) for the additional service to be implemented by the Authority. Personnel and Operations & Maintenance were well monitored with spending within budget.

All Categories of spending for the year increased compared to the 2017 financial year and this is mainly due to the increased staff allowed in the budget and the additional staff for NECC which commenced half way through the year. Capital expenses also increased considerably due to the implementation of the NECC which required Building Improvements, Computers and Office Equipment as well as the installation of new Billboards to raise the awareness of the general public relative to the one emergency number.

PROGRESS WITH THE CORPORATE PLAN

SFESA is continuously looking for innovative ways to achieve its vision and mission as well as upholding its core values as articulated in its 2017-2020 Corporate Plan. The Authority's Mission Statement is as follows:

Vision:

Commitment to the provision of the best service through innovative training, education and resources.

Mission:

To empower personnel professionally and technically to provide quality and efficient services to the community.

Motto:

To save lives and property.

The 2018 Annual Plan was reviewed to assess the progress of targets and goals that were set for each Department to achieve. We acknowledge that there were challenges given the first Annual Plan implemented by the Authority, we nevertheless were able to achieve over 50% of targets and goals set as an Organisation. It must be noted that the 29% of targets that were not achieved were due partly to increased roles and responsibility required of the Authority that existing staff could not undertake. Additionally, these goals and targets are prioritised for completion in the new financial year.

- ✚ The Authority continues to monitor its key performance indicators and we are happy to report that we continue to maintain the required level of preparedness at all times of 1- 2minutes when responding to any emergency. Furthermore, we continue to respond in 10 minutes for all emergencies within the 5 mile radius of the town area.
- ✚ We are also pleased to report also that one of the major component of the Corporate Plan required the strengthening of its Medical Team. In May 2017, the Authority's Commander Medic commenced studies for a three year Bachelor of Paramedicine in Victoria Melbourne. In his absence, we have been fortunate to secure the services of a qualified Volunteer Paramedic through AVID and she has been instrumental in the capacity building of ambulance staff and overseeing the work of the ambulance vehicle. This coincides with the increased role of the ambulance services as a result of the initiation of the one emergency number.
- ✚ Training and capacity building of staff is another major component of the 2017.2020 CP. Numerous up skilling of staff and technical trainings were undertaken during the year to ensure that promotions were done on the merits of staff members attaining a certain level of capability and expertise.
- ✚ Awareness Programs to Schools and Communities through affiliations with other central agencies is one of the key targets that the Authority exceeded for the year. The Fire Safety Department has worked hard to ensure that these programs are undertaken from grass root level up to commercial operators and businesses to ensure that safety messages reach as many people as we can, to contain emergency incidences for safer communities.

CAPITAL EXPENDITURE AND PROJECTS

There were several capital procurements and projects that were targeted to be procured and completed in 2018.

- ✚ The Turbo Ladder Truck and the Tanker donated by the Government of Japan arrived in February 2018 and is now used by the Authority for its response services. Furthermore, the government funded ambulance vehicle for the Authority was also procured within the year.
- ✚ Due to the growth of the staff, the Board approved the extension to the west wing to cater for the increase in staff members. The work included the construction of a Sleeping Quarter for the Apia Station and the relocation of the kitchen to the extended west wing. This was completed and the Fire Safety staff utilise the new extension. There was also major repairs and maintenance work undertaken for the Faleata Station Kitchen and Mess area as the old Mess Room was not suitable for Health and Safety reasons.

- The establishment of the NECC required major renovation works to the South side of Faleata Station. Whilst this was not in the CP, it was nevertheless required to be completed to ensure smooth operations for NECC staff on inception of their services.

FUTURE RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES

- As a beneficiary body, SFESA continues to be funded primarily by the Government of Samoa. As such, there is no certainty that we will continue to be prioritised for funding in the government budget every year and we risk compromising this crucial service to the people of Samoa.
- One of the biggest risk that is faced by the Authority every year is its aging fleet. Maintenance of these specialised vehicles continue to rise every year whilst spare parts are difficult to be secured locally and have to be sourced from overseas suppliers. The Authority has not been able to procure a new fire fighting truck with the exception of the donated ladder truck from Japan in the last financial year. The existing fire trucks are constantly breaking down and if this problem persists, it poses future risks for the Authority and the services it is mandated to deliver. Securing partners and donors that can provide assistance in the form of capital resources is important for the Authority as it is not in a position to finance these specialized vehicles.
- The existing headquarters of the Authority poses a risk particularly its location directly opposite the sea. Furthermore, staff count rise every year and the current facilities are no longer able to cater for further increase in staff which may pose risks in the future. We continue to seek additional land at the Faleata Station to ensure that there is room for extension in the future.
- Personal Protective Equipment and Gear are a necessity for any fire fighter however our ability to procure these highly specialized gear given their cost will always be an uncertainty. We continue to seek assistance from our twinning partner in Melbourne who donated the last PPE gears for the Authority five years ago.

OUTLOOK FOR NEXT YEAR

- ✚ SFESA is excited and welcomes the New Year as it looks to strengthen its service delivery. We have instigated an ambitious new three-year Corporate Plan which has shifted from the last few Strategic Plans that the Authority has implemented. The 2019.2021 CP directly holds each Department of the Authority responsible for the achievement of its set goals and targets shifting away from the collective responsibility of the previous CPs. We believe that this is more challenging and rewarding for the staff of the respective Departments and makes it easier for Management to monitor and evaluate the progress periodically.
- ✚ We anticipate that the obvious upward trend in ambulance call outs will affect our personnel in the next year and it is therefore crucial that we look at options of increasing the staff to cater for this upward trend in the new year.
- ✚ The Authority's Mechanic Division currently utilizes Faleata Station to undertake maintenance of all its vehicles and with the anticipated expanded fleet, there will be a need to expedite the construction of the Mechanical Workshop which has been approved by the Board for construction. This is scheduled to be finalized in 2019.
- ✚ The Authority has envisages the possible construction of a new Fire Station at Faleolo to service the Western side of the Upolu Island. We have experienced over the past several years the rise of emergency incidences in this area and surrounding districts. Moreover developments and Government essential services continue to increase particularly with tourists resorts and accommodations notwithstanding the Samoa International Airport. As such, it is crucial that we provide this service in this area of the country. There are also expectations that the service will be able to operate from other rural areas in the future.

We look forward to the future as we anticipate additional staff members and additional vehicles to expand the current fleet of the Authority as we recognize that both these additional resources will add value to our work as we strive to meet our commitments as stated in our vision and mission.

I acknowledge the support of the Chairman and the Board of Directors for the work of the Authority for the year. Thank you also to the dedication of my Executive Management Team who has made 2018 a successful year for the Authority through their commitment to provide the best services to the people of Samoa. I also wish to thank the work of our staff to ensure that we meet our targets and goals set as we provide the services to the people of Samoa to the best of our abilities.

REPORT OF THE AUDIT OFFICE

TO THE GOVERNING BODY IN CHARGE OF GOVERNANCE – SAMOA FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICE AUTHORITY

Audit Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Financial Statements of the Samoa Fire & Emergency Service Authority which comprise the Statement of Financial Position as at 30 June 2018, and Statements of Comprehensive Income, Changes of Equity, and Cash Flows for the year then ended, and a Summary of Significant Accounting Policies and Other Explanatory Notes. The Accounting Firm of Lesā ma Penn, Chartered Accountants, assisted in the audit. The Engagement Partner on the audit resulting in this Independent Auditor's Report is Magele Arthur Penn.

In our opinion, the financial statements give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Samoa Fire & Emergency Service Authority as at 30 June 2018, and of its financial performance, changes in equity and cash flows for the year then ended, in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS).

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (ISA). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of Financial Statements* section of our report. We are independent of the Authority in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of financial statements in Samoa, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a reasonable basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

Directors and Management are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards and Samoa Fire & Emergency Service Authority Act 2007 and for such internal control as directors and management determine is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, the Directors are responsible for assessing the Authority's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless Directors either intend to liquidate the Authority or to cease operations, or have no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Directors are responsible for overseeing the Authority's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. ANNEX 2: Notes to and Forming Parts of the Financial Statement

SAMOA FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICE AUTHORITY NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2018

1 GENERAL INFORMATION

The Samoa Fire & Emergency Services Authority (SFESA) was established in July 2006. During that time it was operated as of the Ministry of Police & Prisons for two years until 30 June 2008. On 1 July 2008, the Authority became independent and operated on its own except for its payroll, which was processed and monitored by the Ministry of Finance.

Its main functions are set out in Section 4 of the Fire & Emergency Service Act 2007, which are to provide fire suppression and prevention services throughout the independent state of Samoa. Any other functions conferred on to the Authority by or under this Act or any other Act or as directed by the Board of Directors and/or Minister.

2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Set out below is a summary of significant accounting policies adopted by the Authority in the preparation of its financial statements.

a) Statement of compliance

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standard, issued by International Accounting Standard Board (IASB).

b) Basis of preparation

The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost except for buildings at which have been revalued.

c) Functional and presentation currency

The financial statements are presented in Samoan Tala (SAT\$), which is the Authority's functional currency and all values presented in Samoan Tala have been rounded to the nearest Tala.

d) Bad and doubtful debts provision

Collectability of trade receivables is reviewed on an ongoing basis. A provision is raised for any doubtful debt based on a general review of the outstanding amounts at the end of the reporting period. Bad debts are written off against the provision for doubtful debts in the period in which they are identified as unrecoverable.

e) Grants, aids in assistance, donations and capitalisation

The above are treated in the accounts in accordance with their nature and the form in which they are received;

- i. All items which are intended for the support and financing of the Authority's operations and received in cash are taken to statement of comprehensive income.
- ii. All items which are received in the form of depreciable assets, are charged to deferred income in the year of receipt and will be amortised according to the estimated useful life of the asset.
- iii. All items that are received in the form of depreciable assets from the Government of Samoa are capitalised.

f) Property, Plant and Equipment

Property, plant and equipment are depreciated at rates estimated to write off the assets over their useful lives. Straight line method is used to depreciate all fixed assets of the Authority.

g) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents in the statement of financial position comprise of petty cash and cash at bank.

h) Income Tax

SFESA is a public authority and so is exempted from income tax under Section 17 (1) of the Income Tax Act 2012.

i) Value Added Goods & Services Tax (VAGST)

All amounts are shown VAGST exclusive except for trade receivables and trade payables or otherwise stated.

2 STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (cont'd)

j) Trade and other receivables

Trade and other receivables are recorded at expected realization value after providing for bad and doubtful debts. At the end of each reporting period, the carrying amounts of accounts and other receivables are reviewed to determine whether there is any objective evidence that the amounts are not recoverable. If so, an impairment loss is recognised immediately in the statement of comprehensive income.

k) Trade and other payables

Trade and other payables are recognized at cost and represent liabilities for goods and services provided to the Authority before the end of the financial year that are unpaid and arise when the Authority becomes obliged to make future payments in respect of the purchase of these goods and services.

l) Employee Benefits

i.) *Salaries and wages, annual leave and long service leave and other entitlements*

Liabilities for employees' entitlements to salaries and wages, annual leave, long service leave and other current employee entitlements (that are expected to be paid within twelve months) are accrued at undiscounted amounts, and calculated at amounts expected to be paid as at reporting date. Liabilities for other employee entitlements, which are not expected to be paid or settled within twelve months of reporting date, are accrued in respect of all employees at the present value of future amounts expected to be paid.

ii.) *Superannuation contributions*

The Authority contributes towards the National Provident Fund, a defined contribution plan in accordance with local legislation and to which it has no commitment beyond the payment of contribution. Obligations for contributions to the defined contribution plan are recognised immediately in the statement of comprehensive income.
