### In the News: Tariff or no tariff

There was no escape from the main topic of conversation in April: the tariff gameshow where the host went all in with his joker card, doubled down and then threw the board in the air. There is not enough space to go through Liberation Day and the subsequent tariff increases and pauses, suffice to say that it caused chaos across markets and politics. The S&P fell 12% in 6 days, 10 year Treasury yields rose by 0.5% in 7 days and the VIX (the S&P "fear" index) rose by 60% in 2 weeks.

When President Trump promised a "boom like no other" in March, I am not sure that is what he meant. As for his 100<sup>th</sup> day of office "revolution of common sense" speech, well take a listen and make up your own mind....he is still going after Fed Chair Jerome Powell because the President "knows interest rates better".

Markets have, however, rebounded and settled a little while the world takes stock but the question is how much irreversible damage has been done to global trade, US reputation/safe haven status and political world order.

In the UK, 10 year Gilt yields are back up to 1998 levels and Keir Starmer had to recall parliament to rush through a bill to save Scunthorpe's British Steel plant and keep the blast furnaces going.

In Europe, no official reason has been provided for the power outage in Spain and Portugal, allowing speculation and conspiracy theories to proliferate, from cyber warfare to renewable energy. The fact is that the impact was quick and widespread with homes, industry and transport all knocked out.

What does all this mean? From what I have been reading nobody knows but uncertainty abounds.
