2 cars are in the lot. 1 more car arrives.

How many cars are in the lot now?

The answer is: 3



You **add** to find how many cars are in the lot.

Plus sign +

The + sign is used when you **add** two numbers together. Think of this sign as the word **and**.

2 + 2 is the same as 2 **and** 2.

Equal sign =

The = sign is used to show the answer of a math sentence.

Think of this sign as “**the answer is**.”

2 + 2 = 4 is the same as

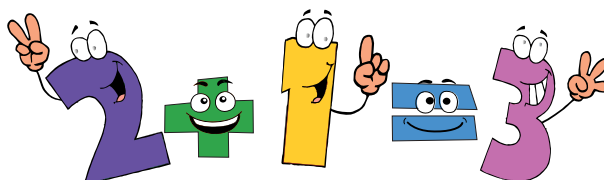
2 + 2 “**the answer is**” 4.



You can say: Two cars **plus** one car **equals** three cars.

Or you can write: 2 + 1 = 3
plus equals

We call this an **addition sentence**.

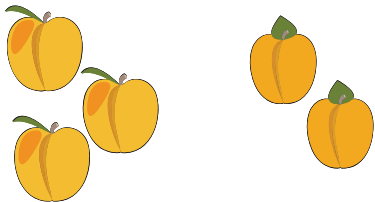
