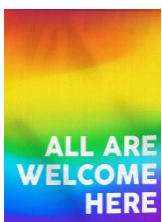

About Evelyn Underhill

Evelyn Underhill was a laywoman in the Church of England, active between the First and Second World Wars who 'never ceased researching, never ceased learning 'and sharing her discoveries through over fifty books and articles, retreat presentations and letters to her spiritual directees. After her death in 1941 the Times Literary Supplement described her as *"possessing an insight into the meaning of both the culture and of the individual 'gropings' of the soul that was unmatched by any of the professional teachers of her day"*.
