Assistant Treasurer / Bookkeeper Needed

St Theodore's is seeking a skilled volunteer to assist our Treasurer with bookkeeping and financial administration. This important work helps ensure the smooth management of the parish's finances and supports the ongoing mission of our church. The role includes entering financial transactions, reconciling accounts, paying monthly accounts, assisting with financial records, preparing quarterly BAS returns, and providing support to the Treasurer as required.

Experience using MYOB AccountRight and preparing quarterly BAS returns and monthly reporting is essential.

An honorarium of \$150 per quarter is offered to recognize the importance of this role. A laptop with required software is provided.

A connection with St Theodore's or the wider parish community is desirable, but church attendance is not a requirement.
