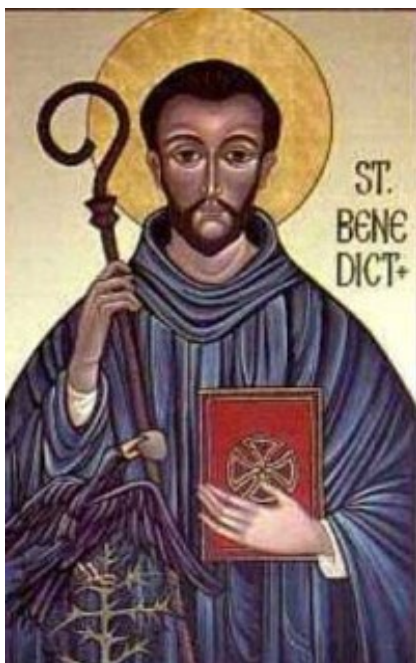
Hearth Gatherings: Encounters with mystics who can light our way.
