Interested bidders are encouraged to inspect the vehicles before submitting their offers at Raising The Village Offices in Kampala at **Plot 19, Kawalya Kaggwa Close, Kololo Hill Drive, Kampala, Uganda** from August 25, 2026, to August 28, 2026, between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. EAT

3. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

For example: **“Bid for the Purchase of Motor Vehicles (DSP-001 – Motor vehicle-UBJ078G)”**

Interested buyers may bid for either one or both vehicles. However, a separate offer email must be submitted for each vehicle.

4. EVALUATION AND AWARD

The successful bidder for each item shall be the bidder offering the highest acceptable price.

Raising The Village reserves the right to:

- Accept or reject any bid.
- Cancel the disposal process without providing any reason.
- Reject the bid if the successful bidder does not make payment within the agreed timeline.

5. PAYMENT TERMS

The successful bidder must pay the full bid amount through bank transfer to Raising The Village within three (3) working days of receiving the award letter or email notification. Upon payment, the buyer will be required to share the proof of payment through logistics@raisingthevillage.org. The buyer will be responsible for all costs related to the transfer of ownership, including but not limited to vehicle ownership transfer fees payable to URA and the cost of obtaining new number plates.

If the successful bidder fails to make full payment for the Motor Vehicle(s) within the specified timeline, the award shall be cancelled, and the Motor Vehicle(s) may be offered to the next-highest bidder.

6. COLLECTION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES

Motor vehicles shall only be released upon confirmation of payment and signing of the sale agreement. All purchased items must be cleared from Raising The Village premises at the buyer's expense within five (5) working days of making full payment. Raising The Village will not be responsible for loading, securing, or transporting the Motor Vehicle(s).

Raising The Village shall not be responsible for any damage or loss after release of the Motor Vehicle(s).
